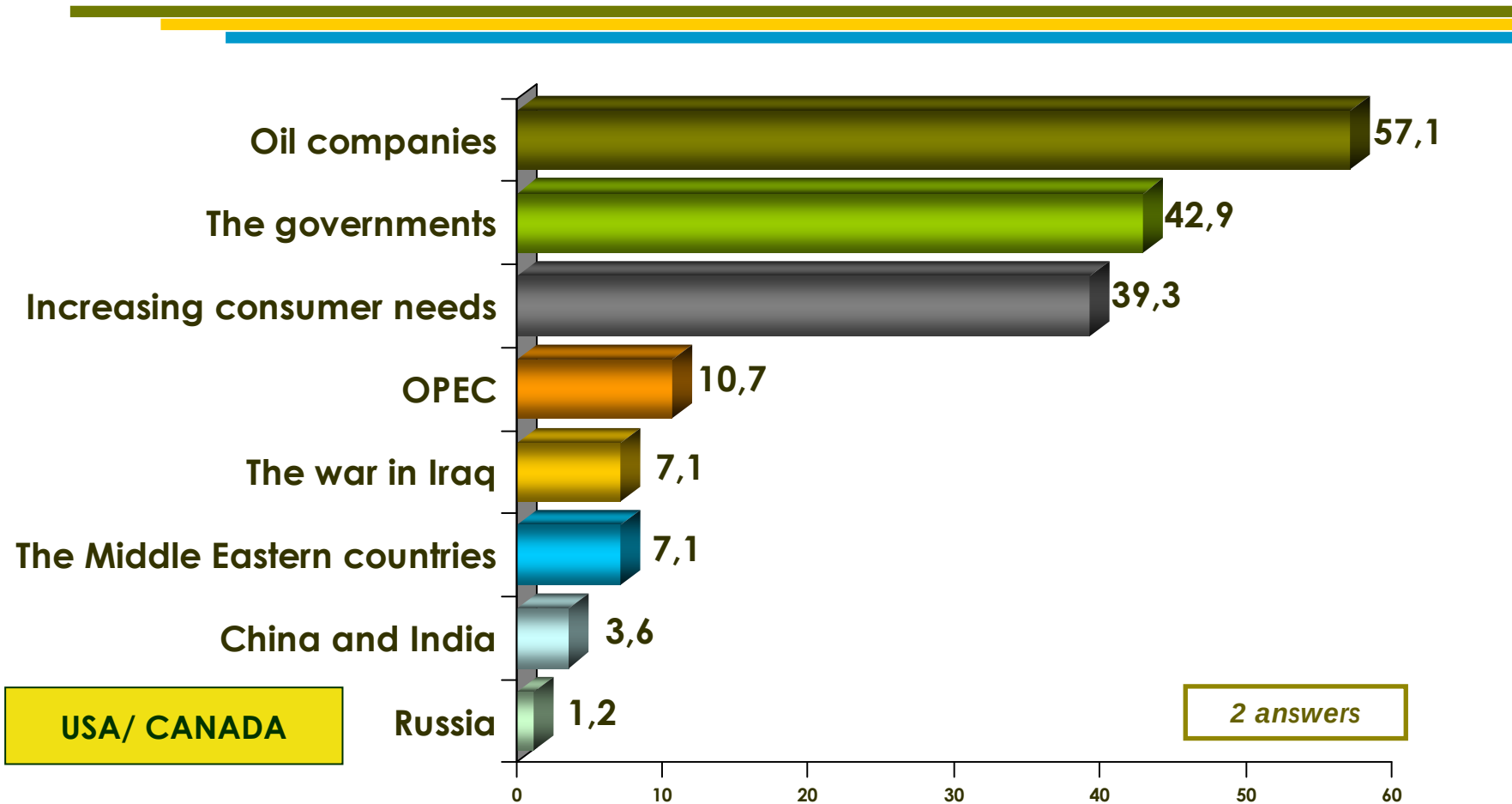


Which of the following actors/events do you consider responsible for the constant rising of fuel and gas prices?



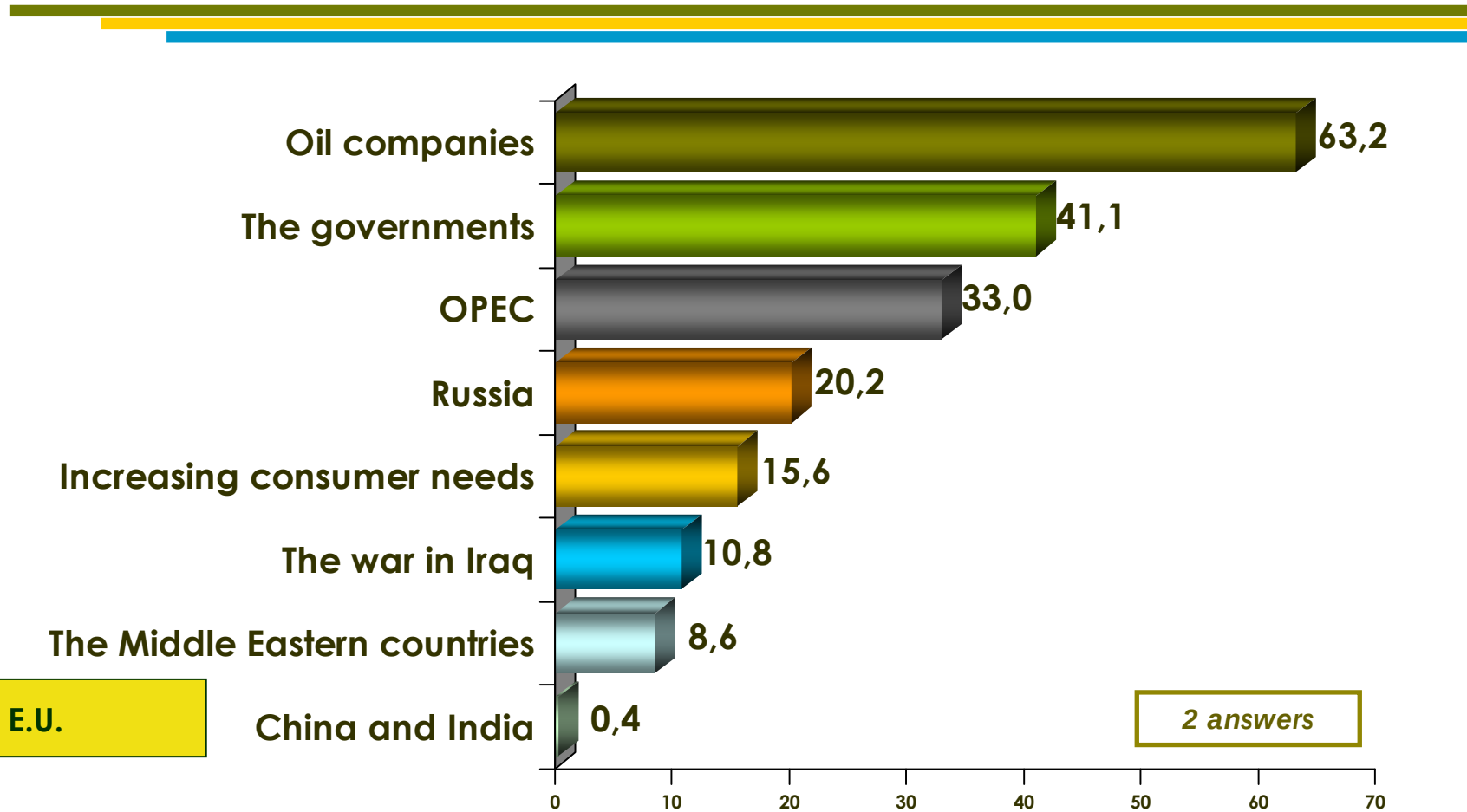

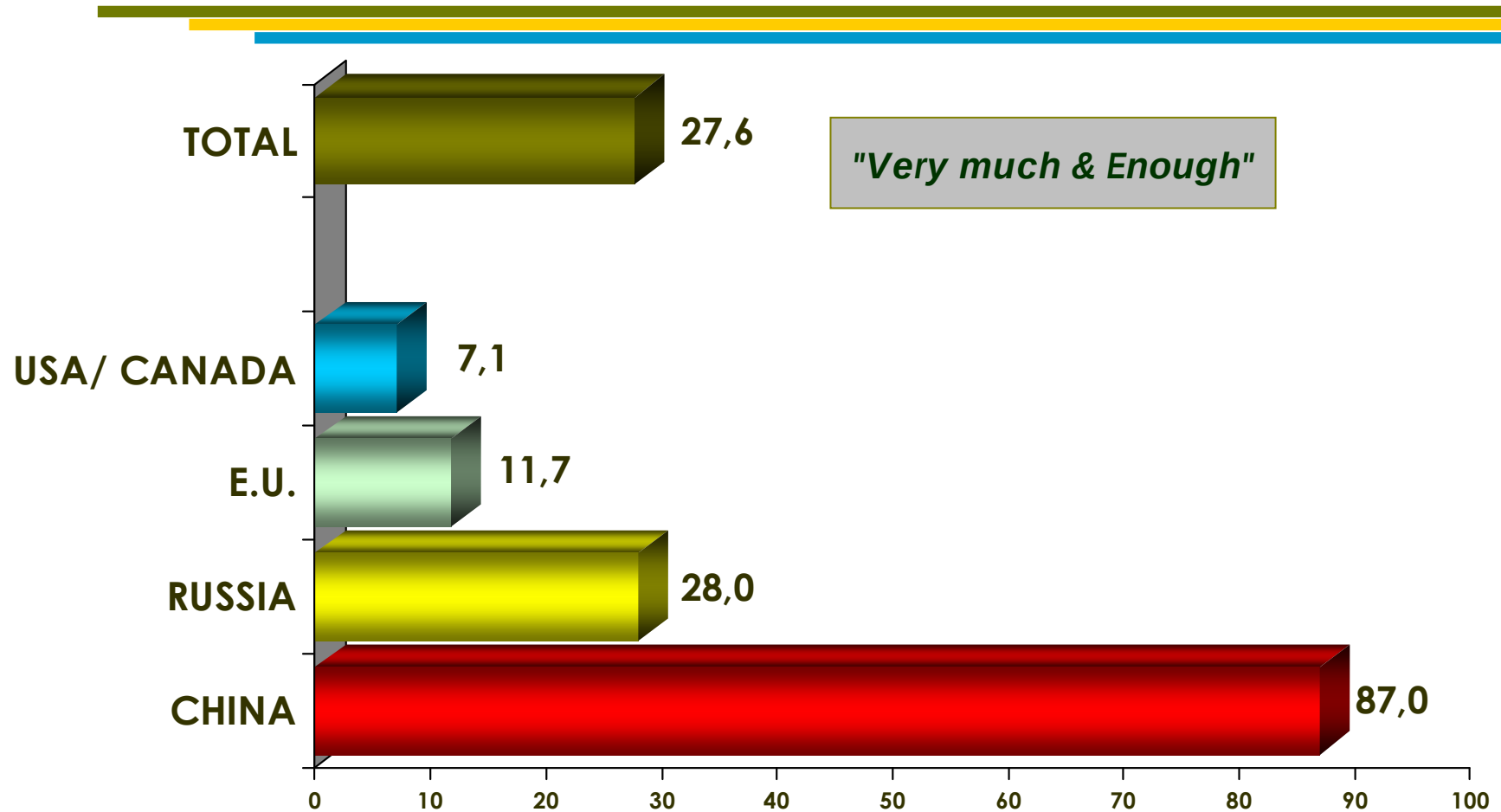
How much do you think your government is investing in developing new secure sources of energy?

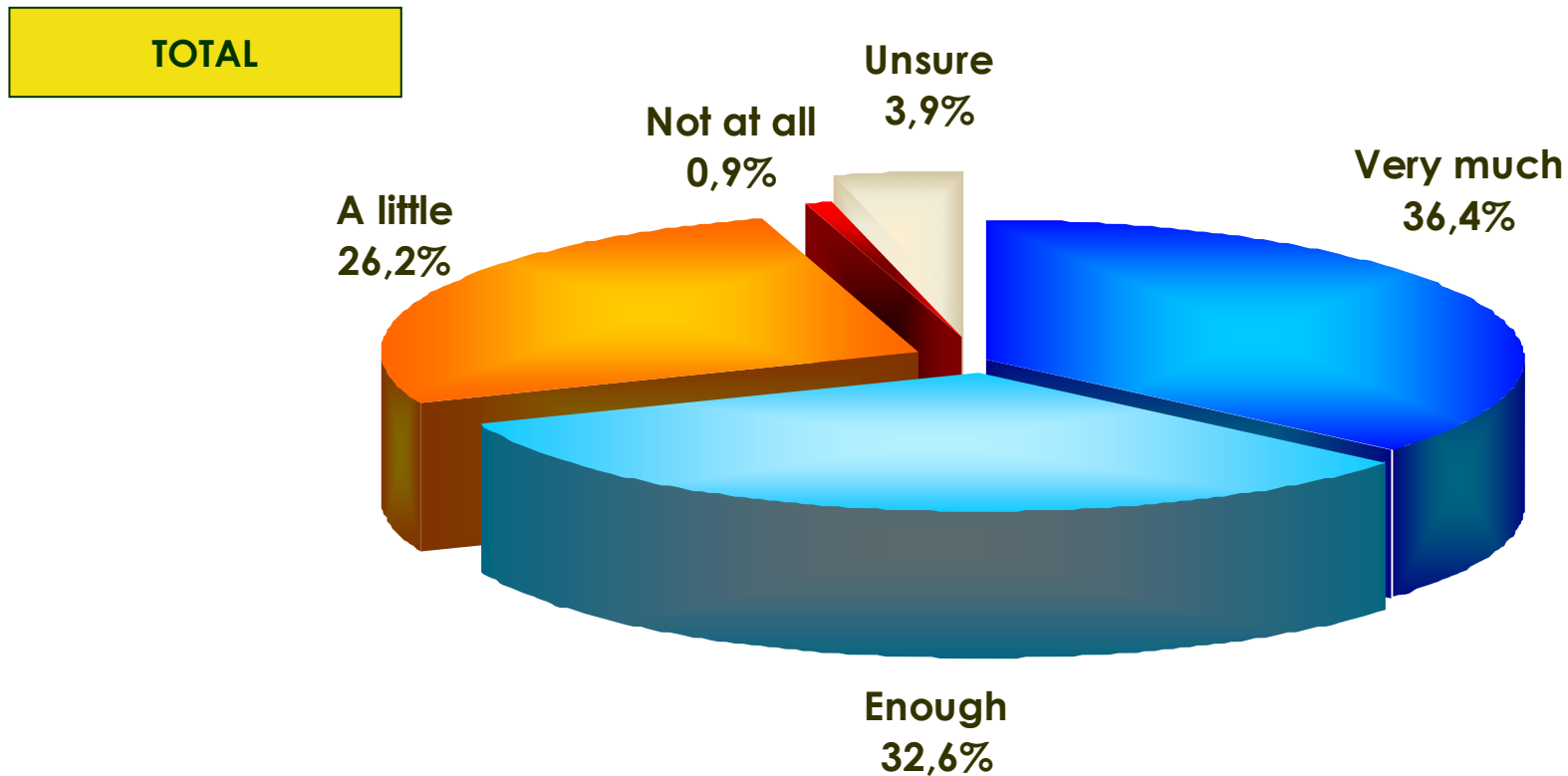

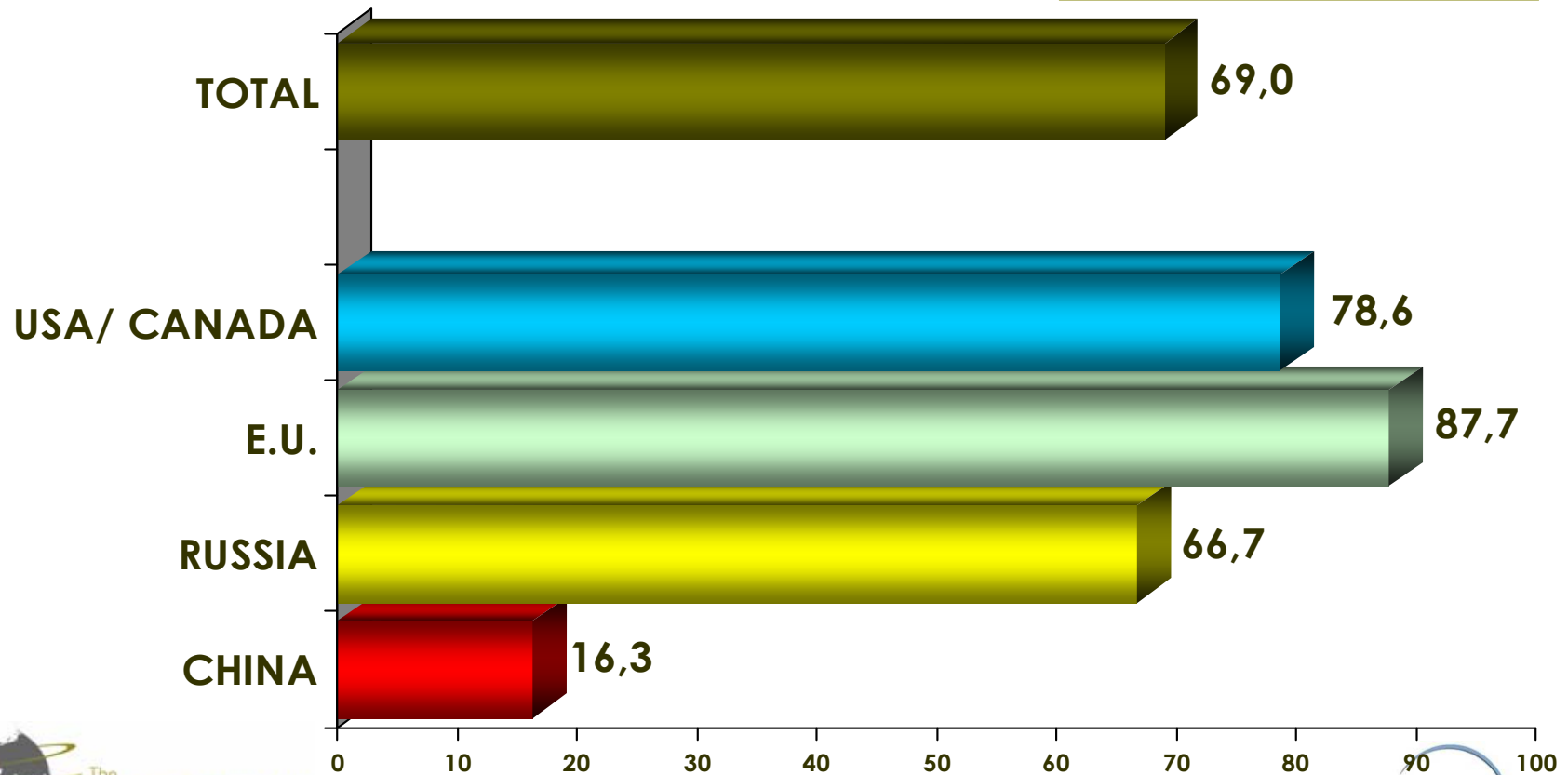
How much does the rise in prices of oil and natural gas affect you personally?





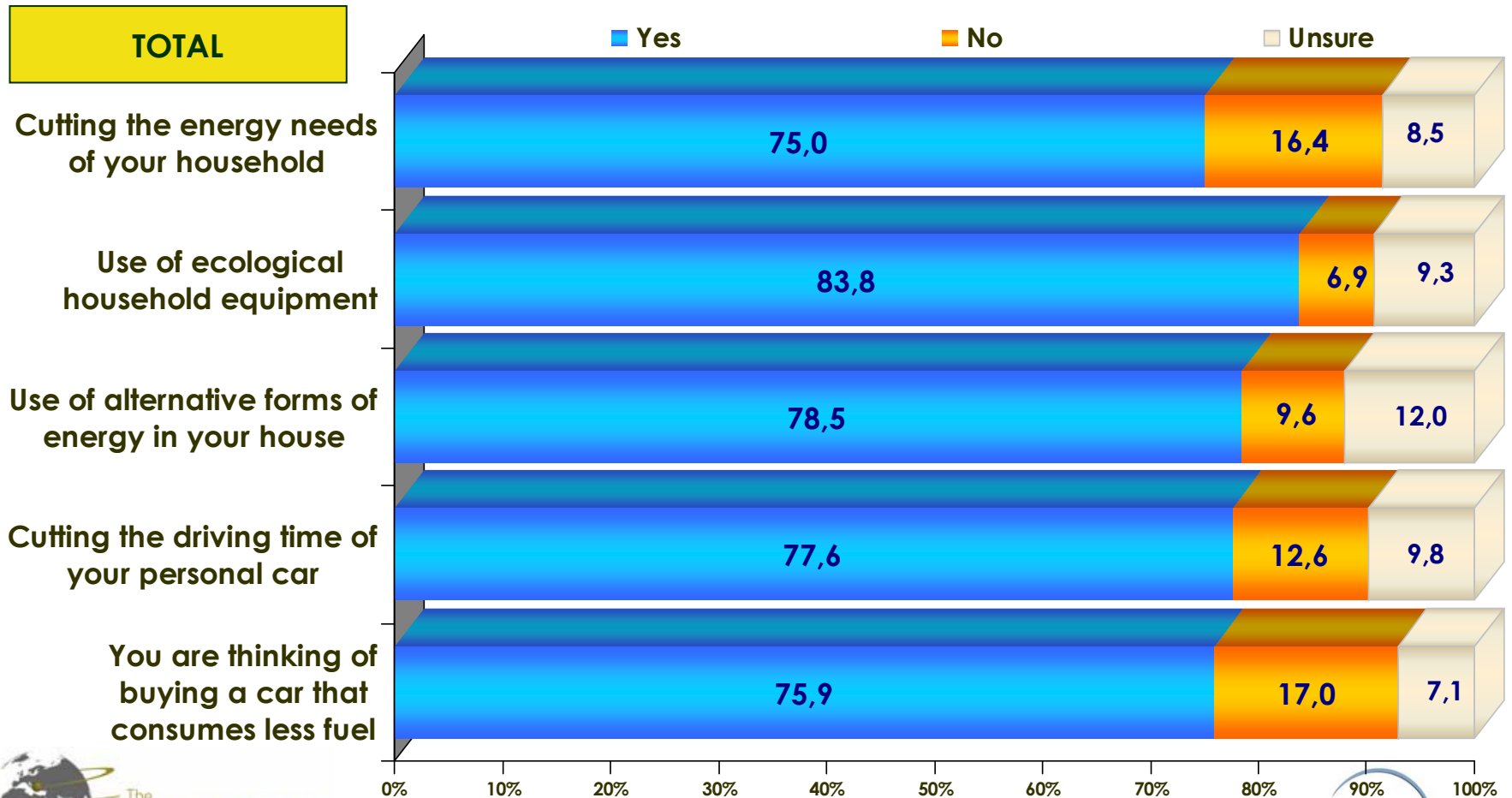

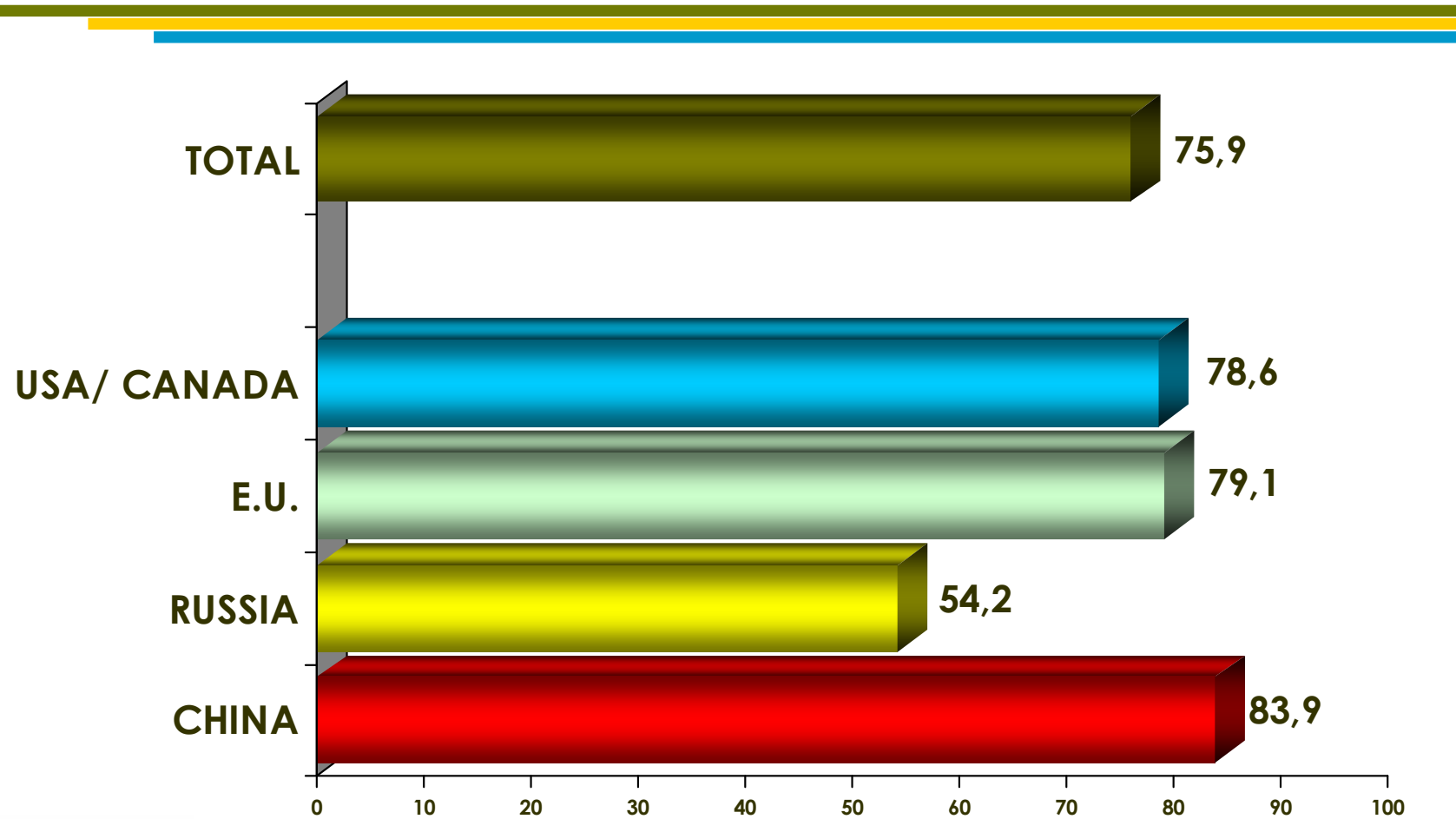

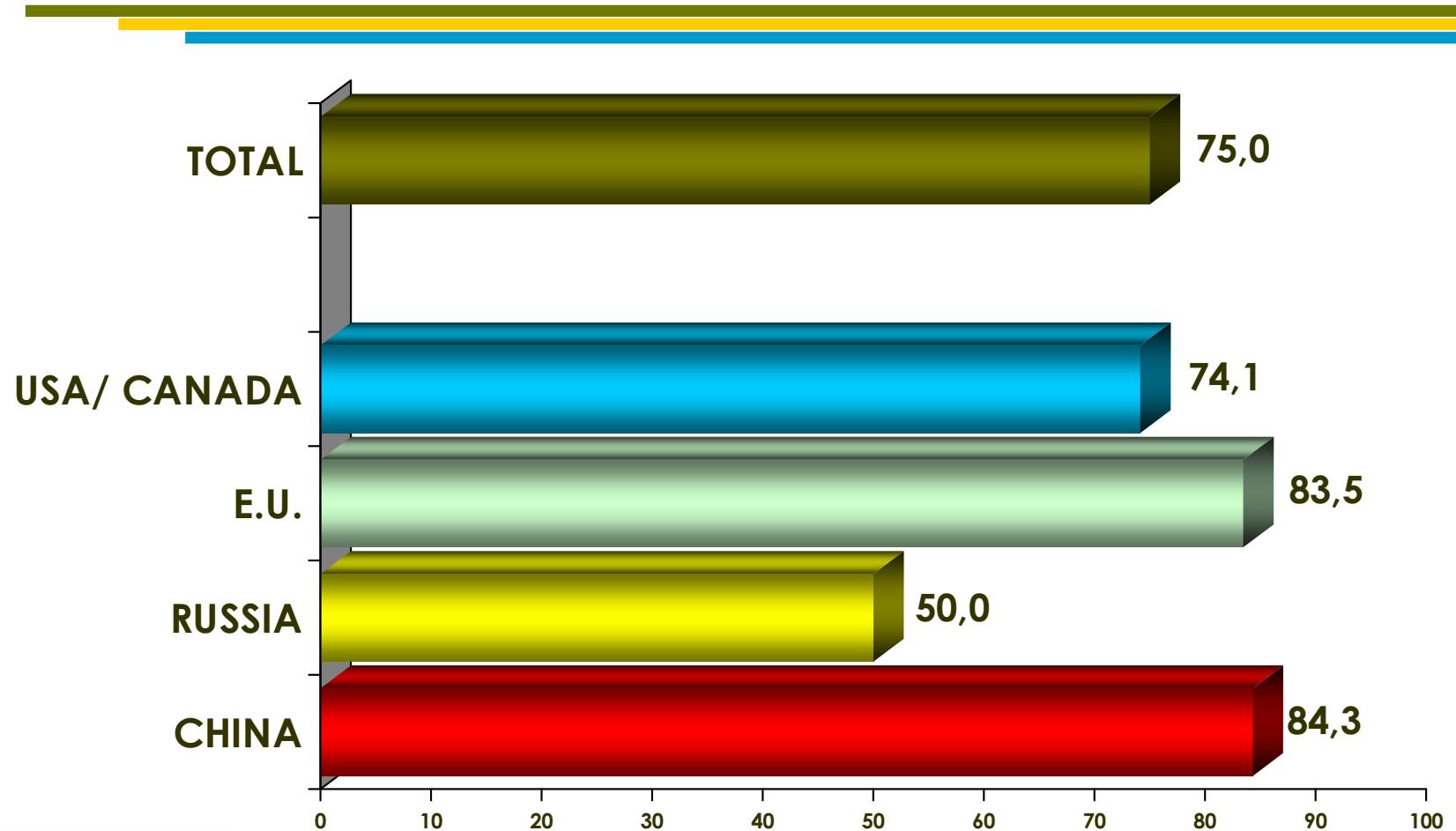

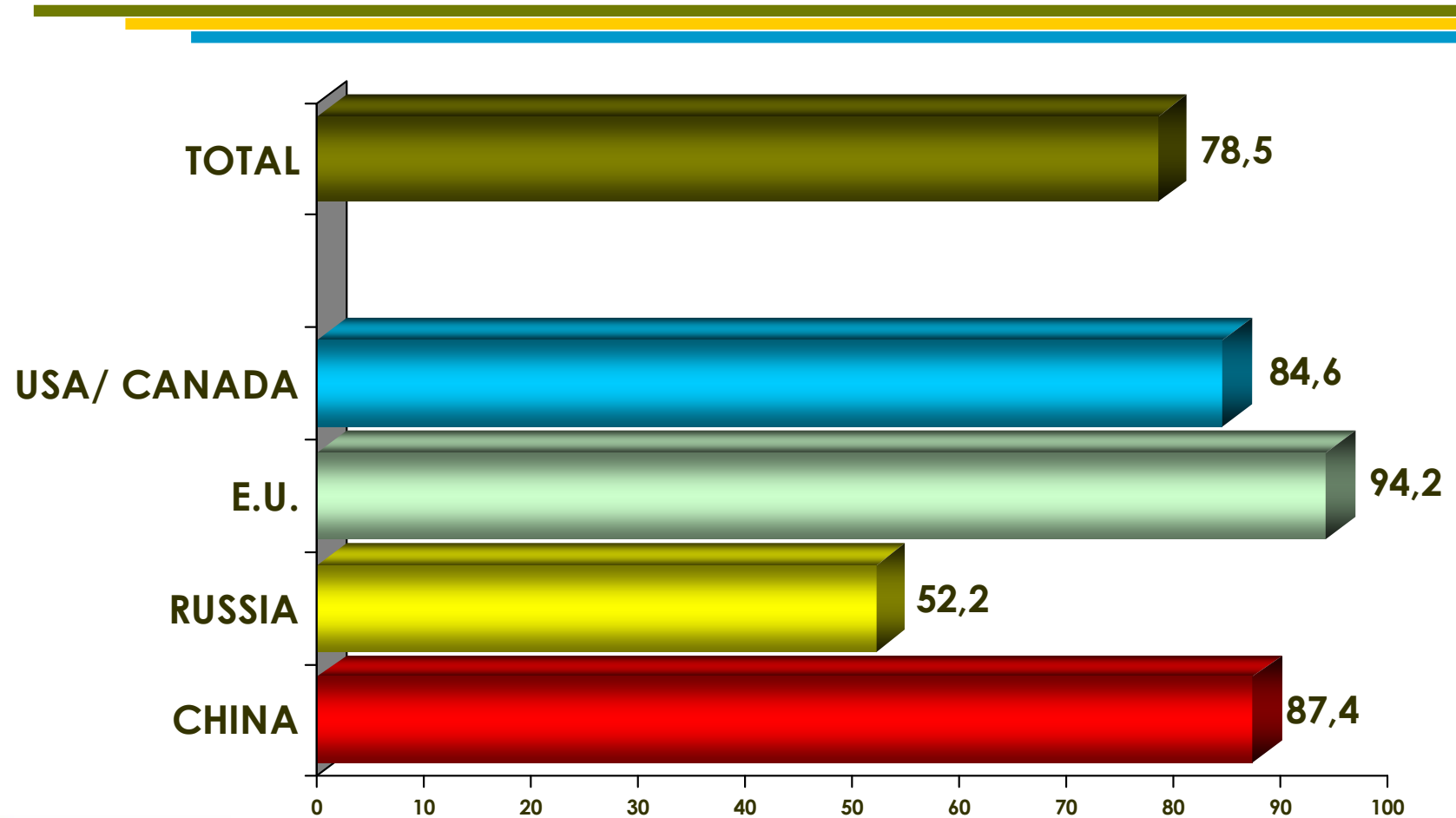

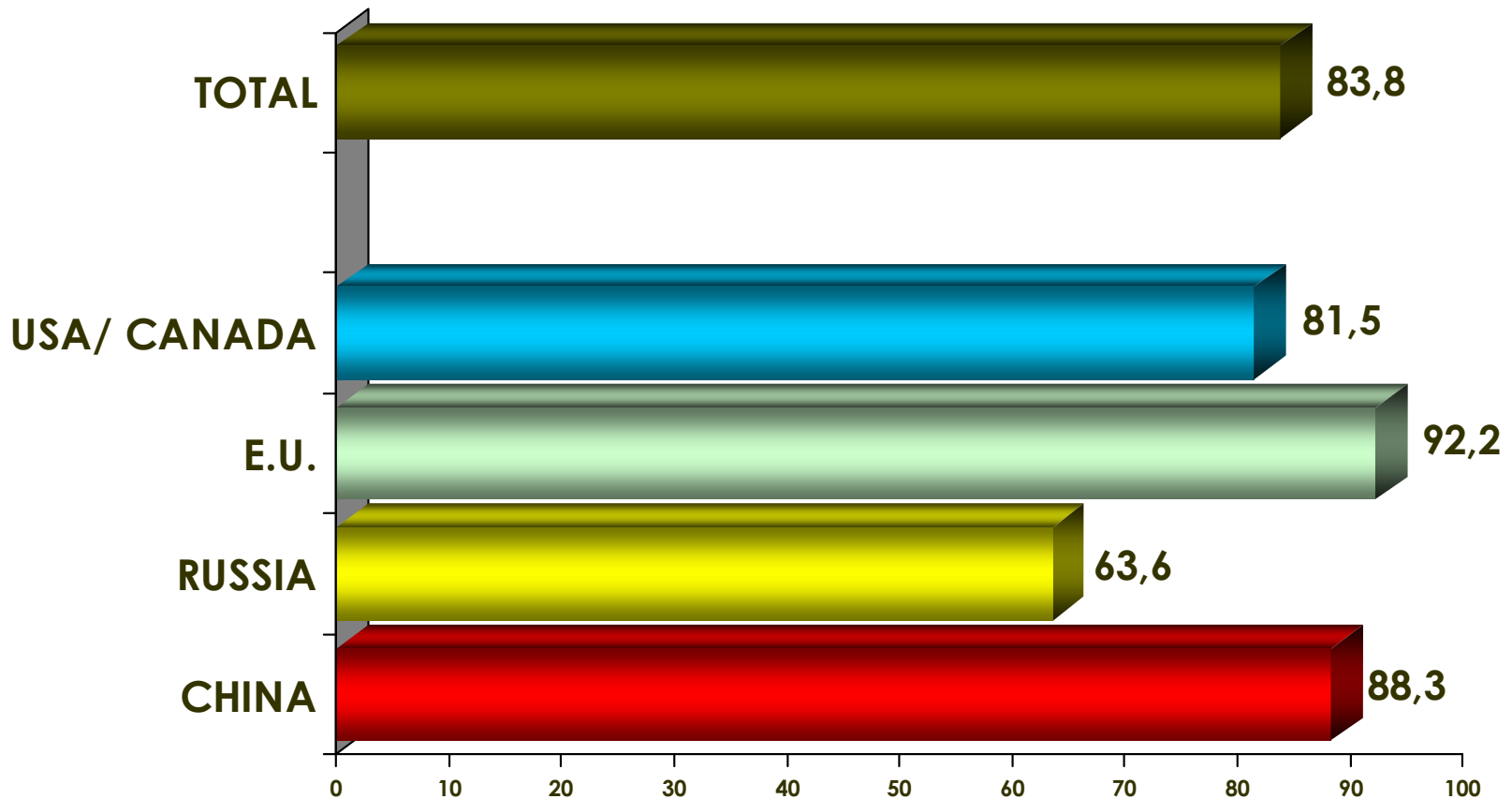

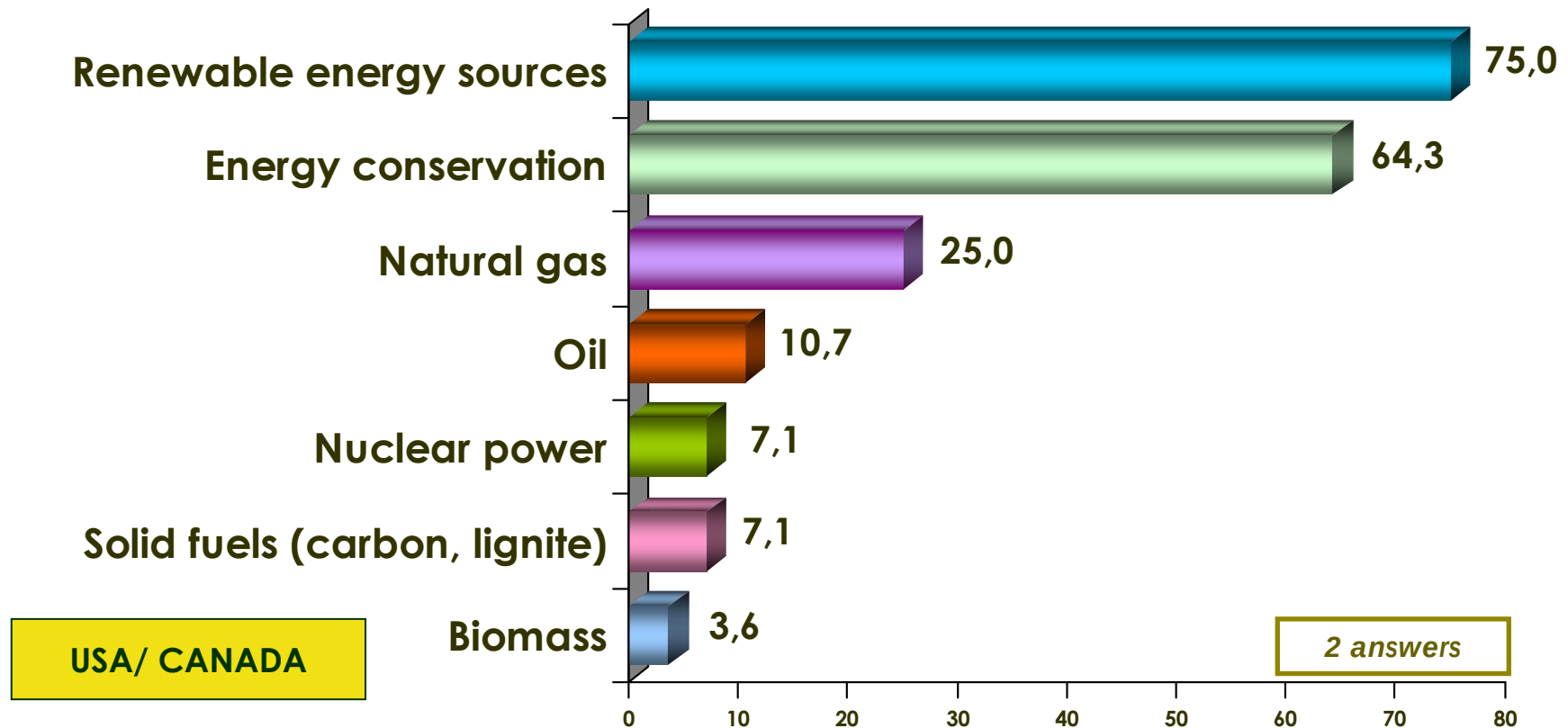


Which of the energy sources below you think that will contribute most in the covering of energy needs in the next 20 or 30 years?



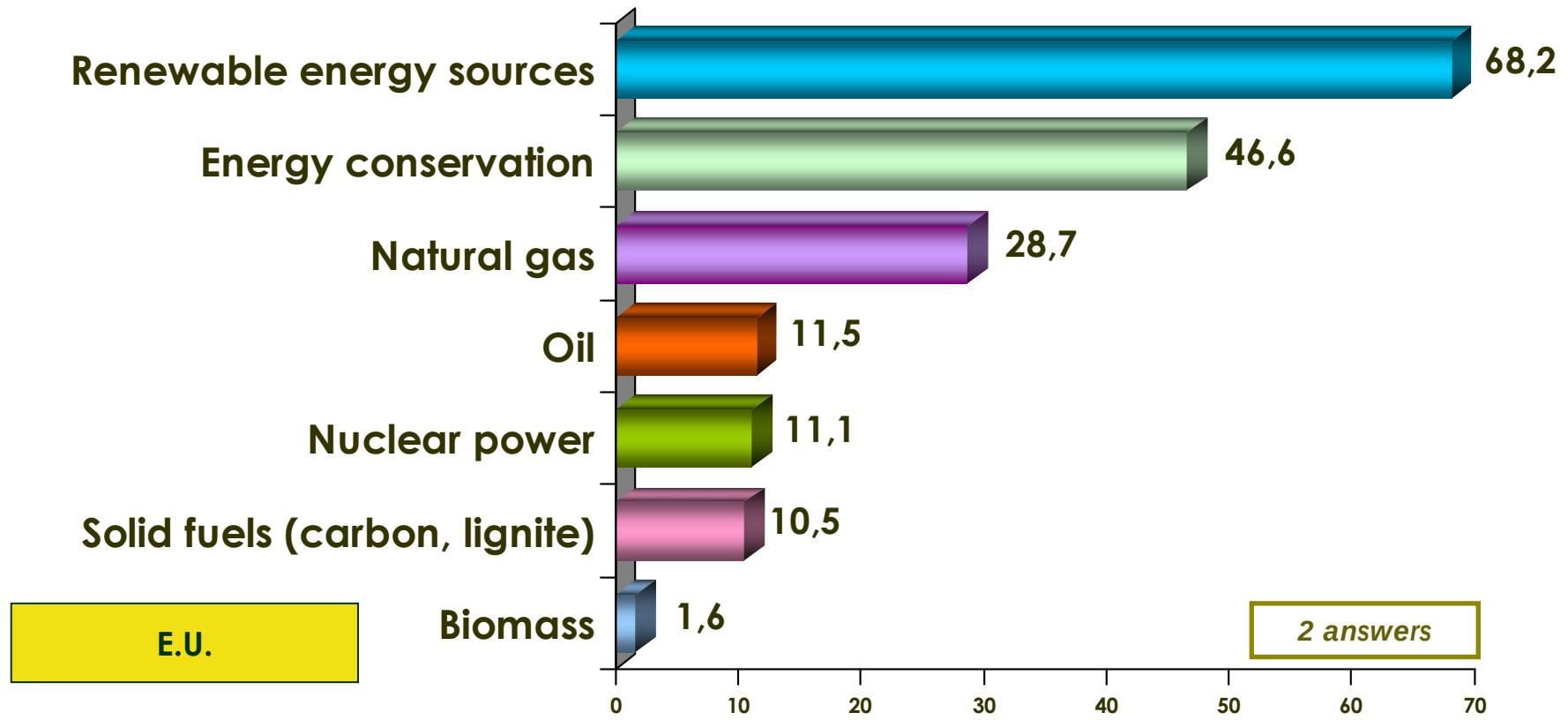

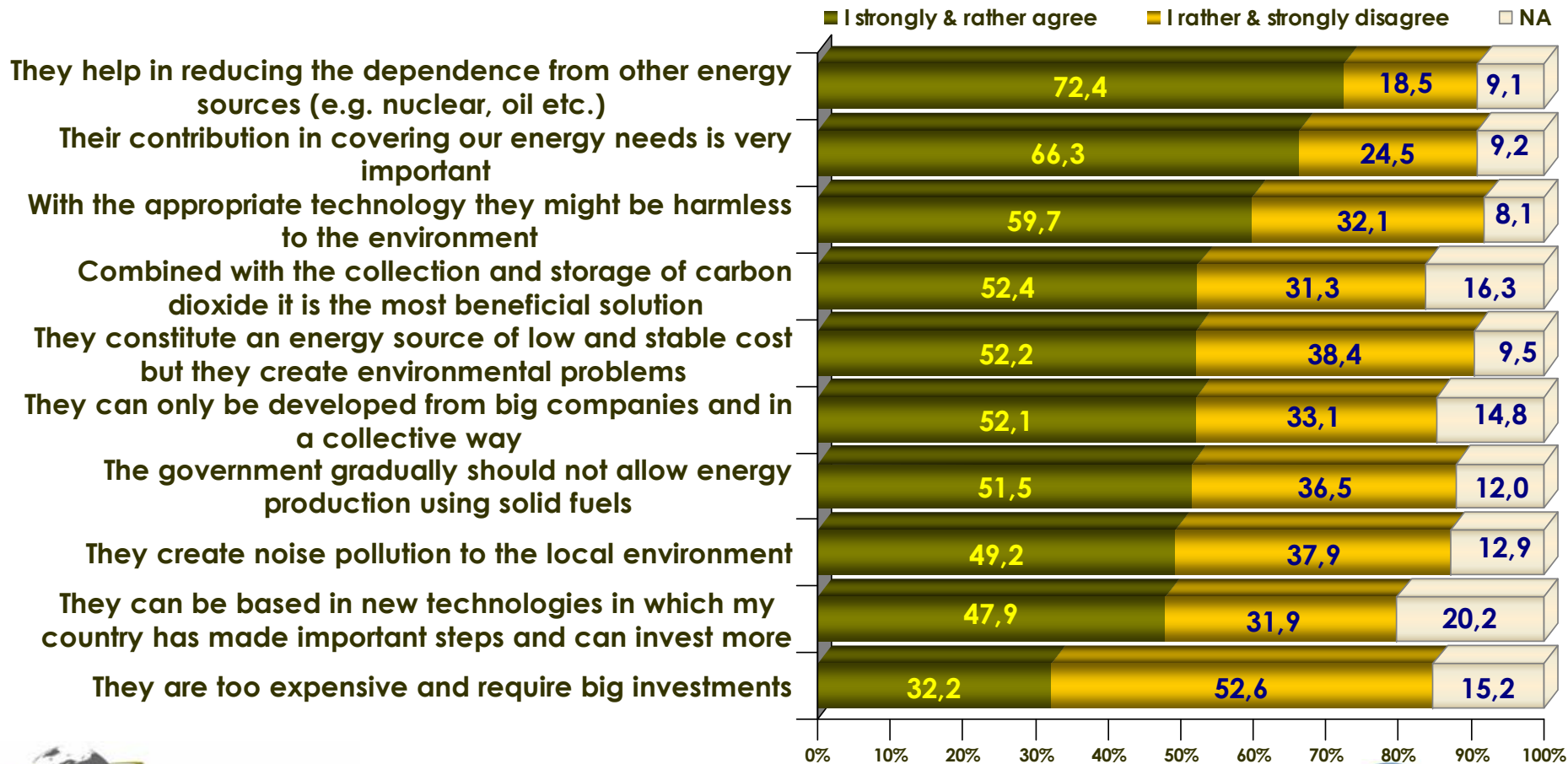


With which of the following views concerning the use of solar energy do you agree or disagree?



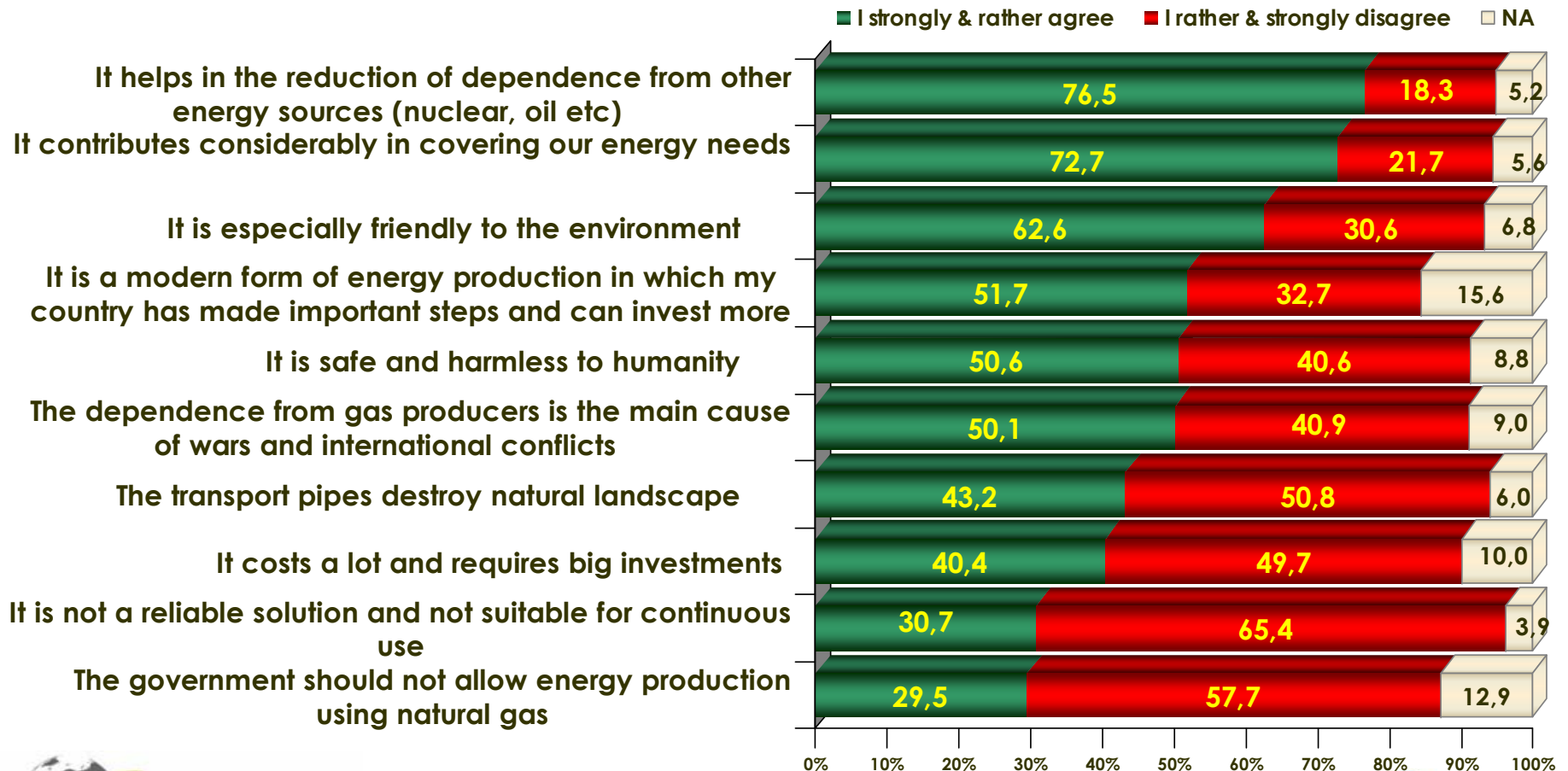


With which of the following views concerning the use of solid fuels do you agree or disagree?



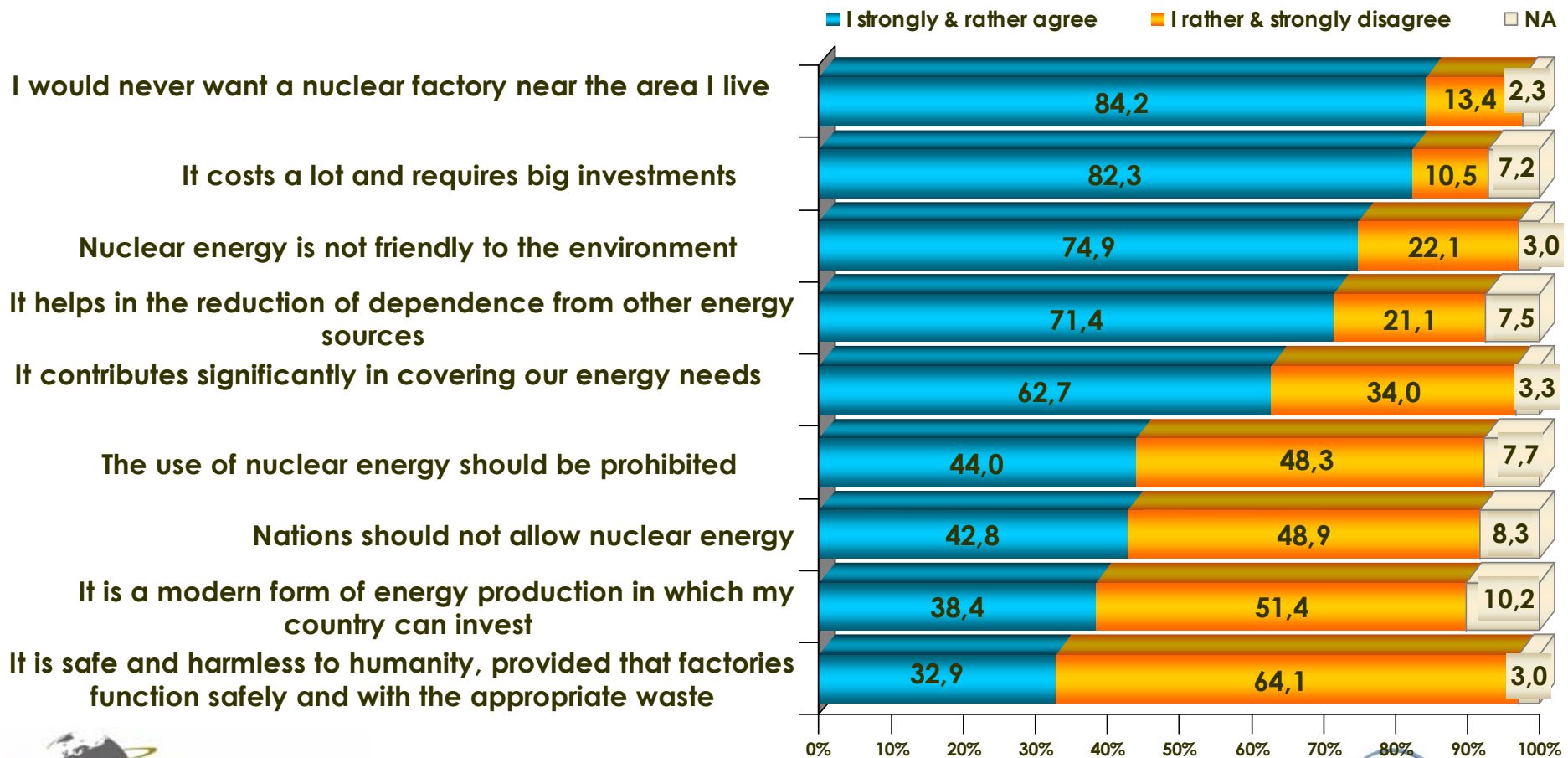

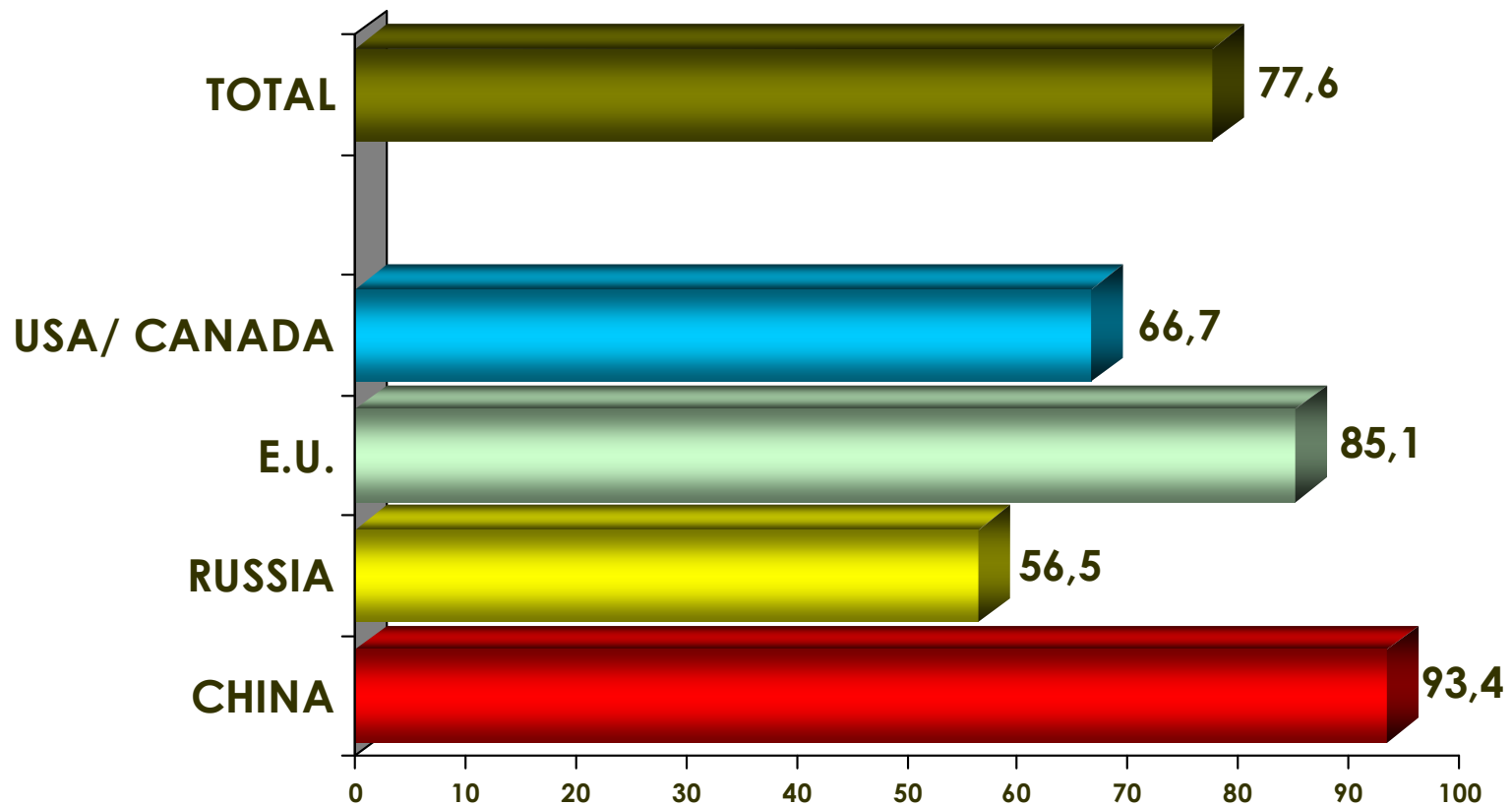


With which of the following aspects concerning global warming do you agree the most?



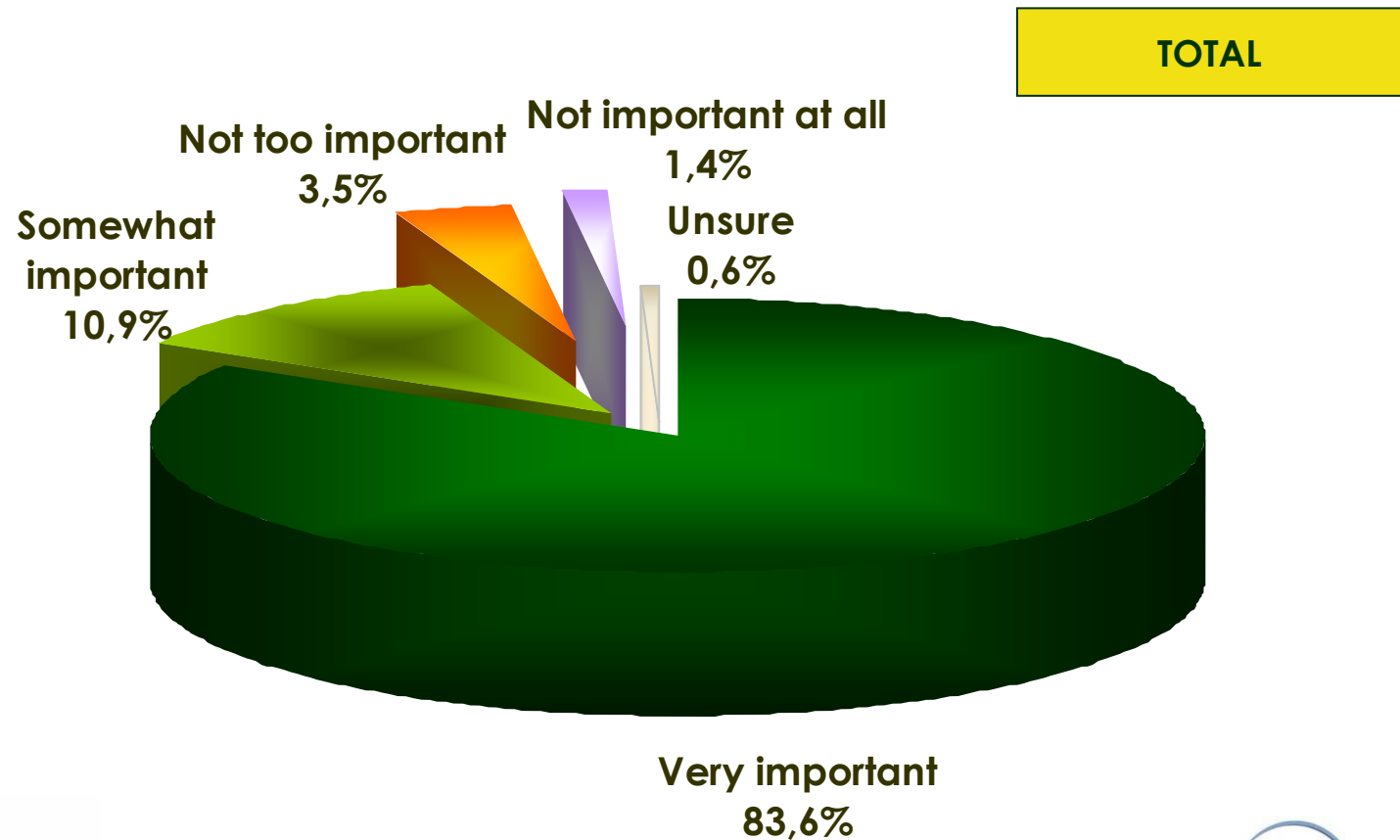

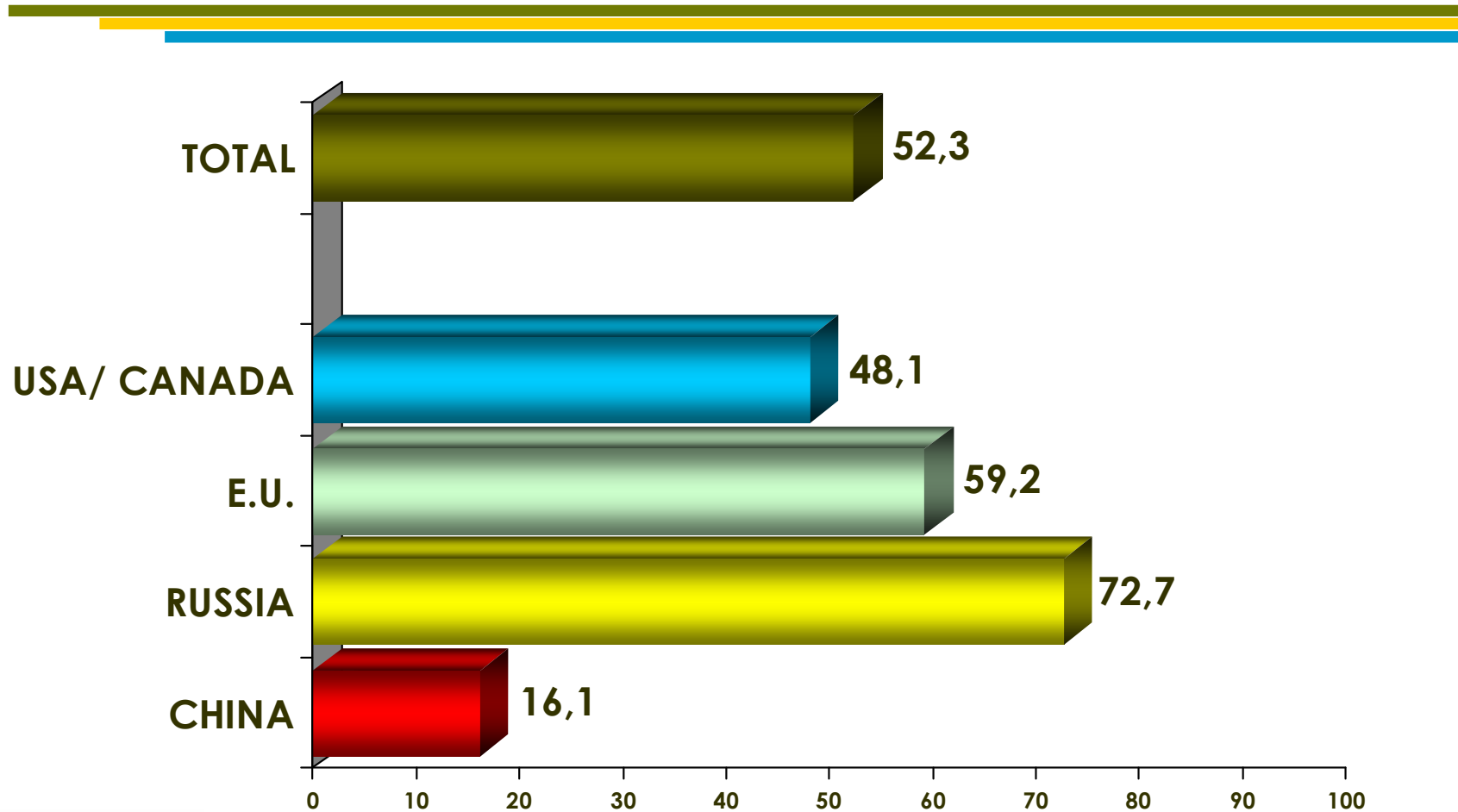

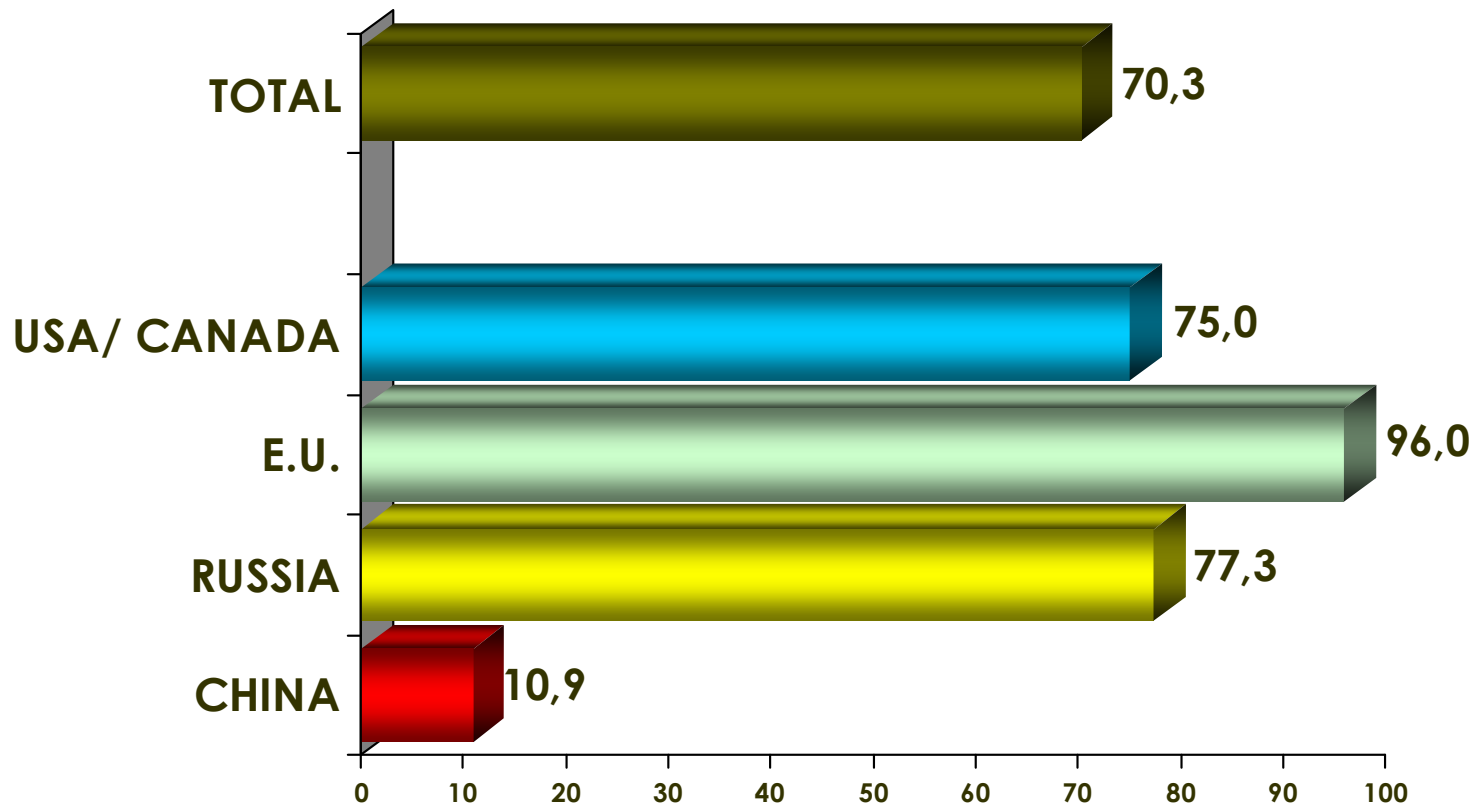

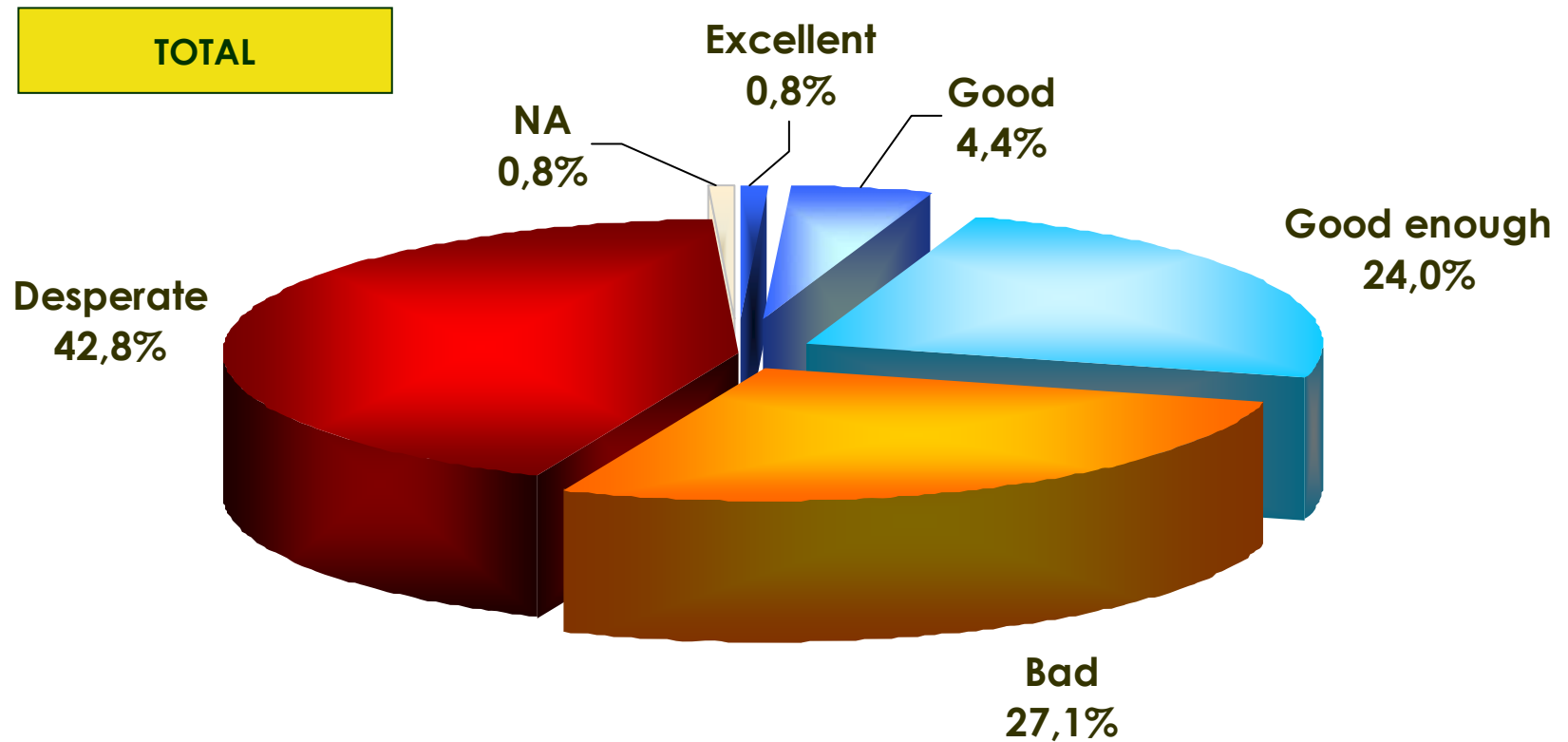

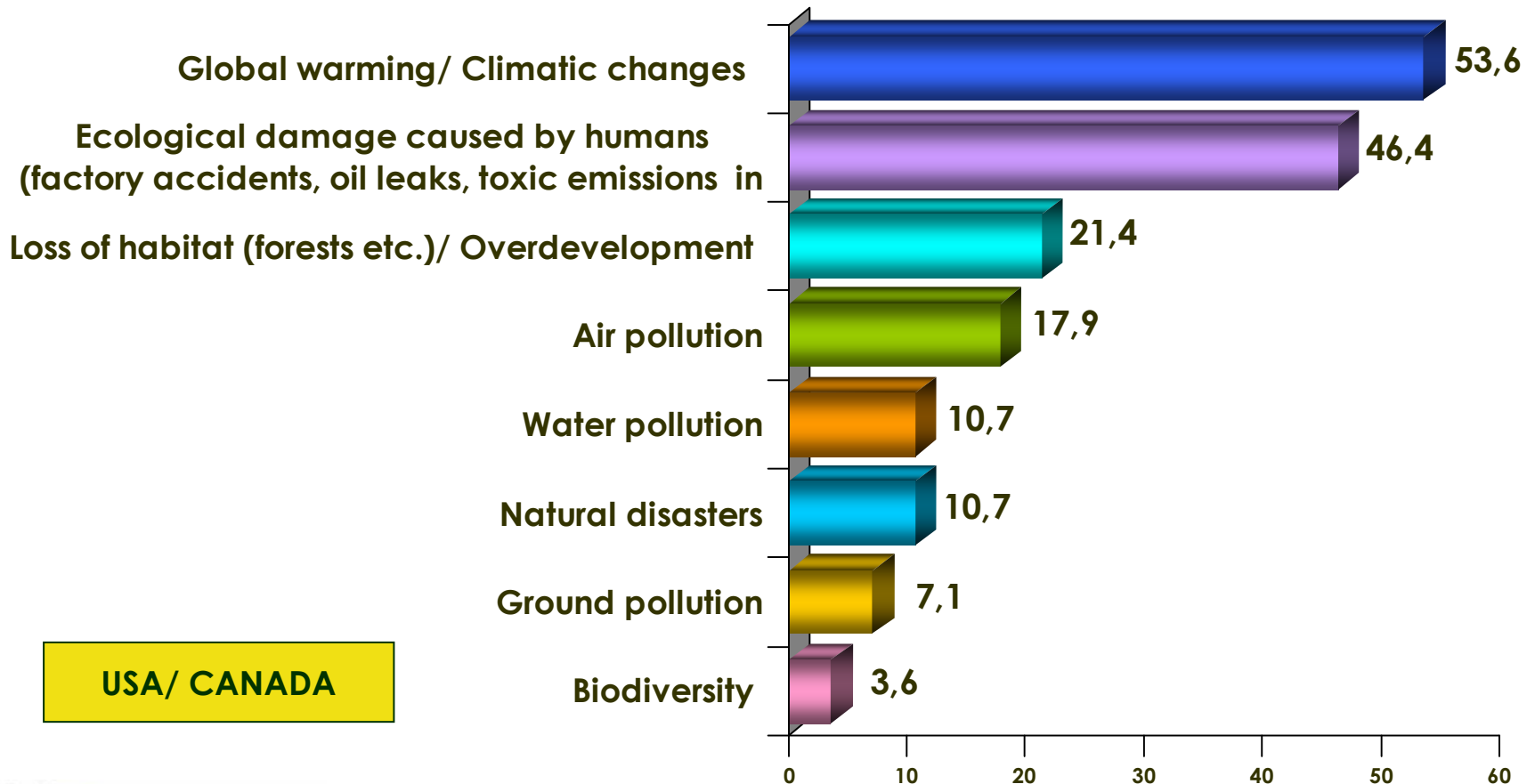


According to your opinion, what is the biggest problem of the world environment today?





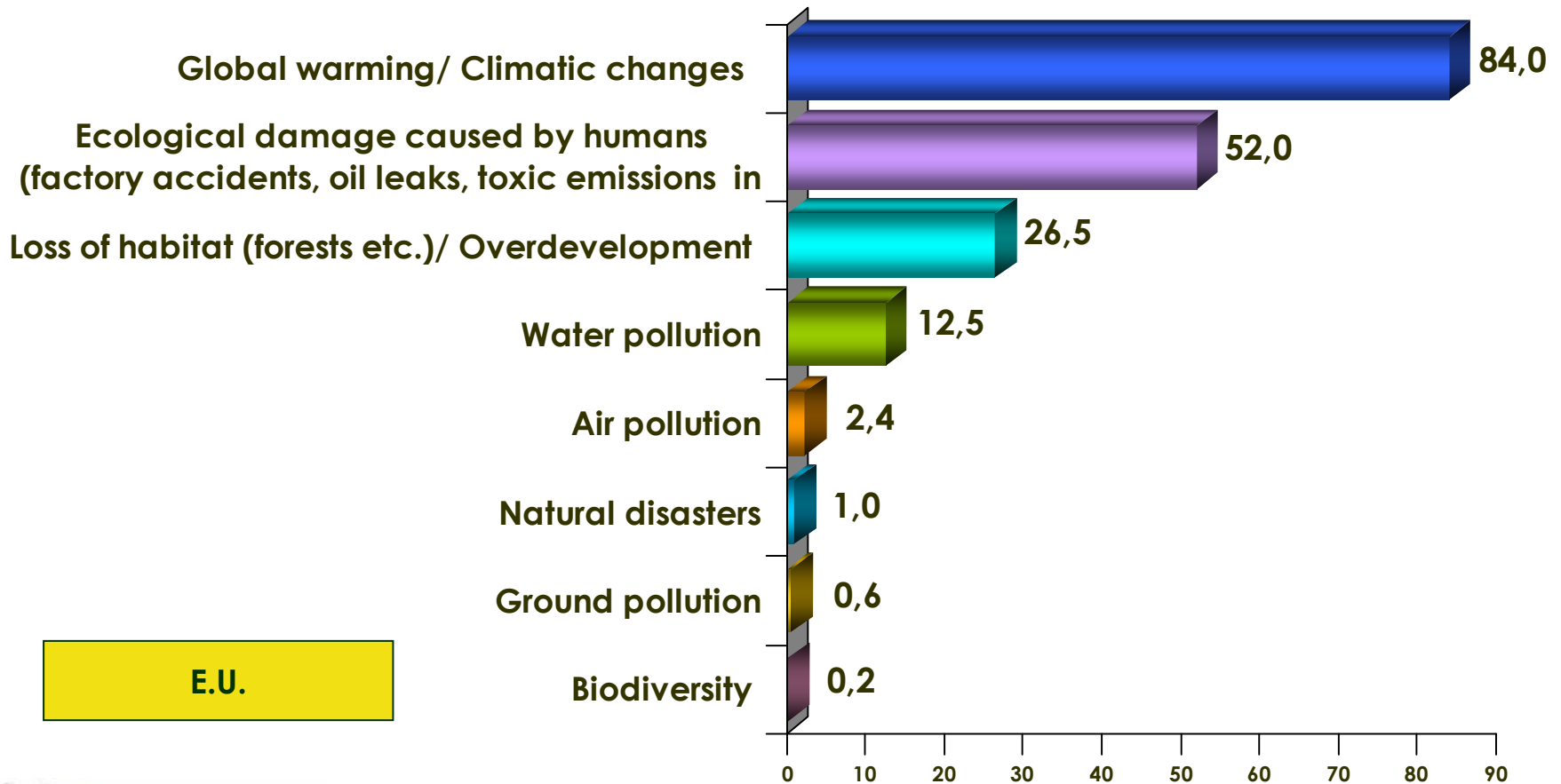

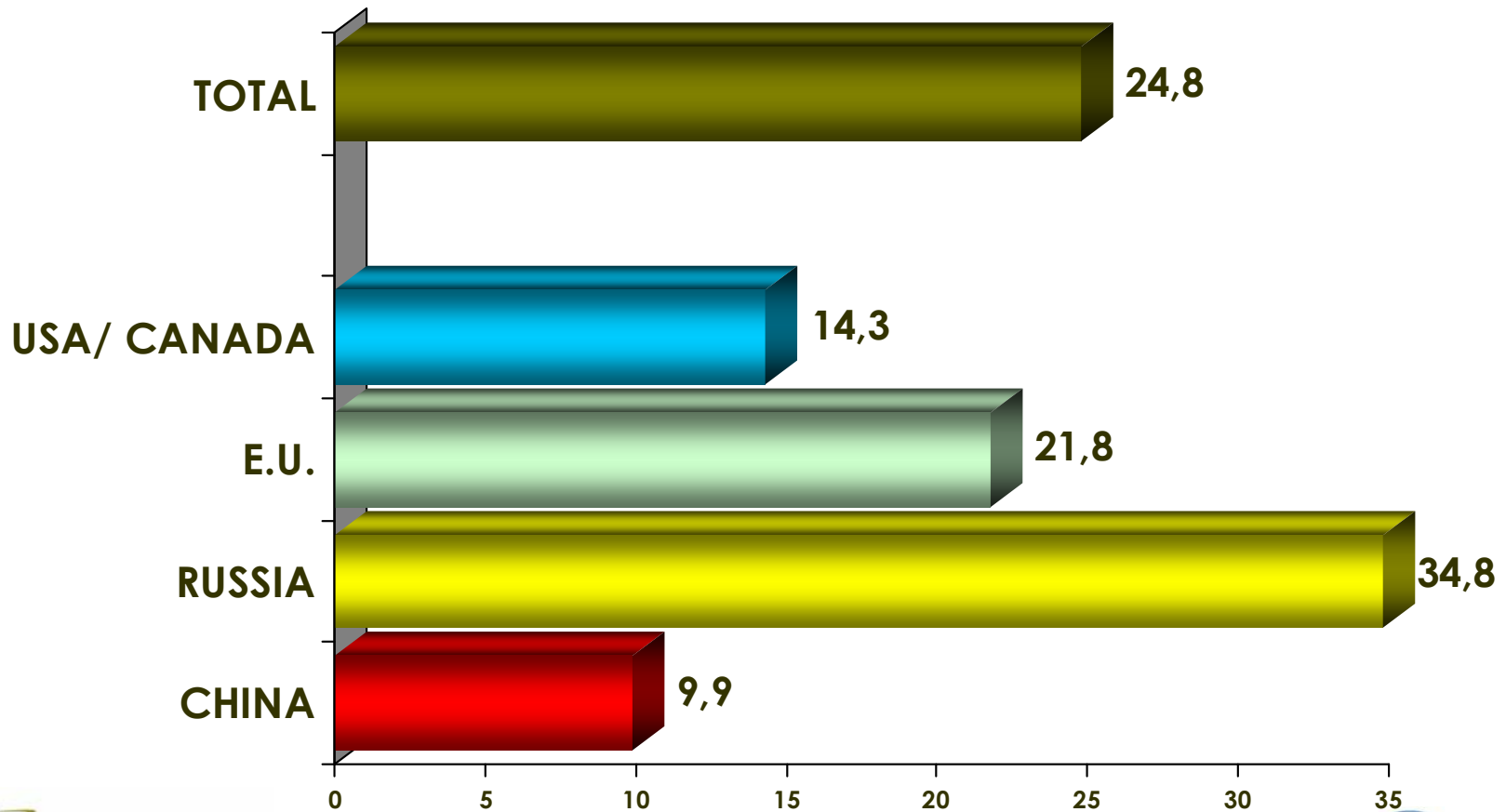


Generally speaking, do you think improving the environment conflicts with economic growth, or do you think improving the environment does not have to conflict with economic growth?



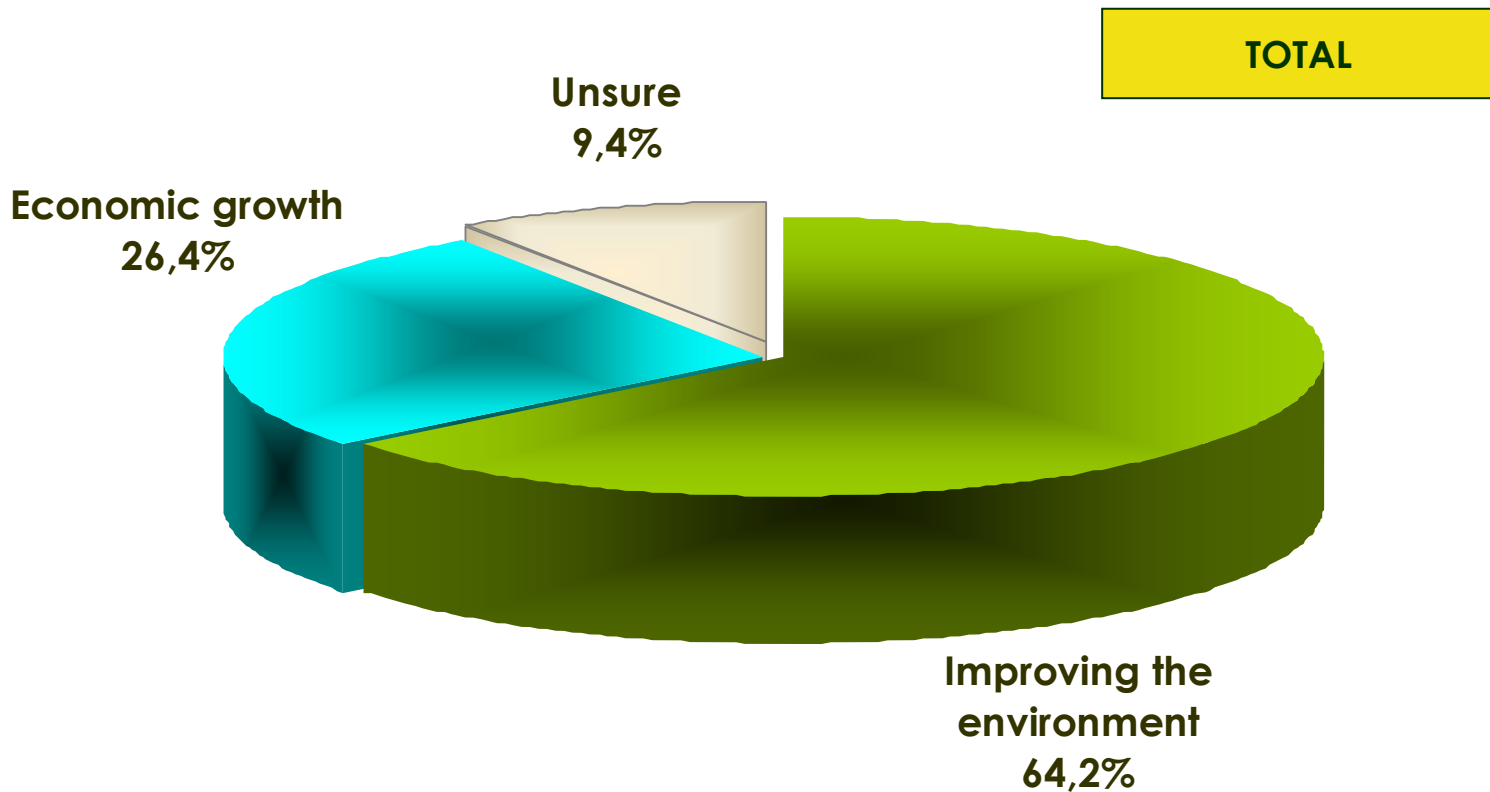

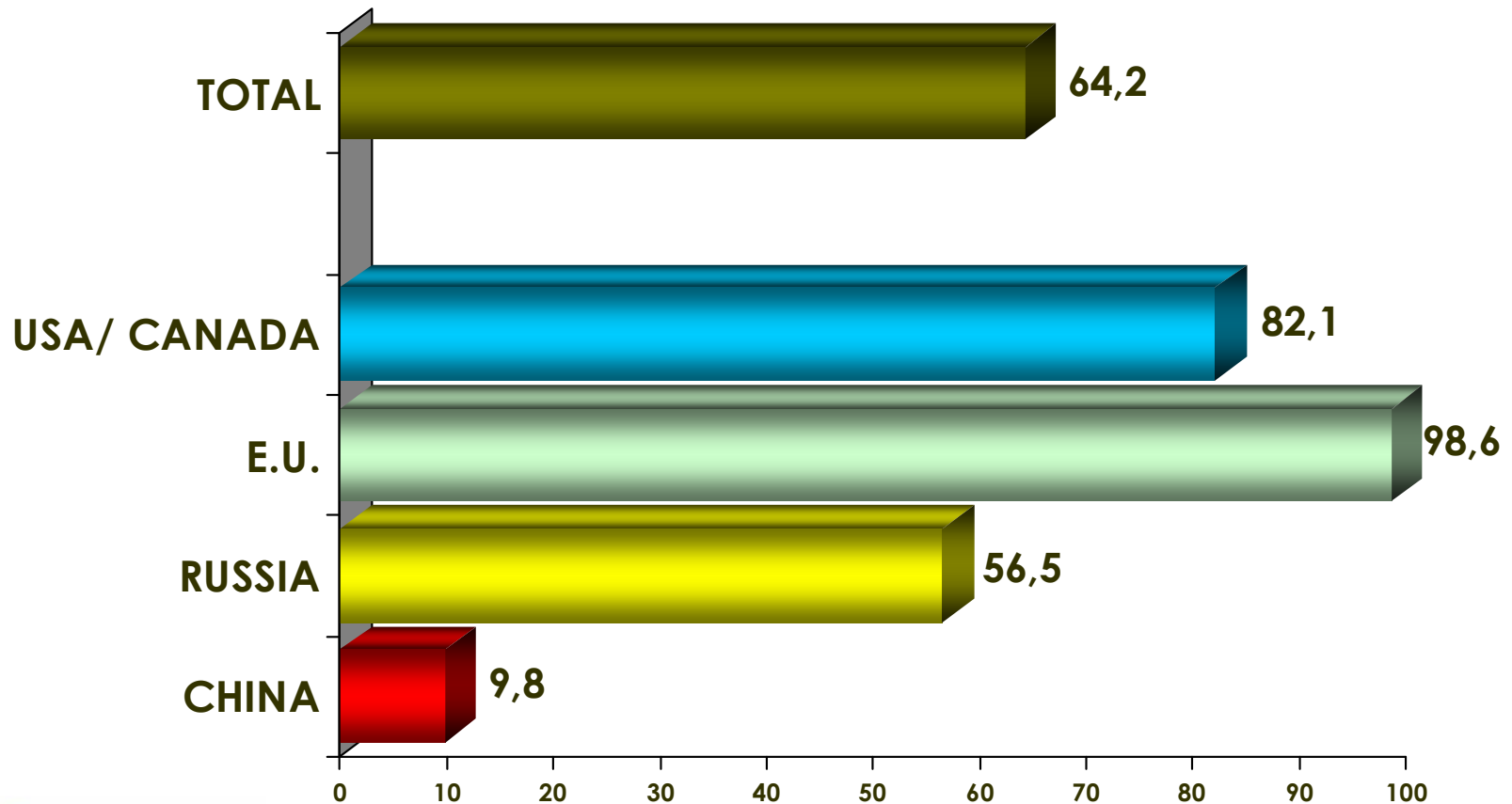


Whether or not you personally think improving the environment conflicts with economic growth, if there is a conflict, which should take priority?



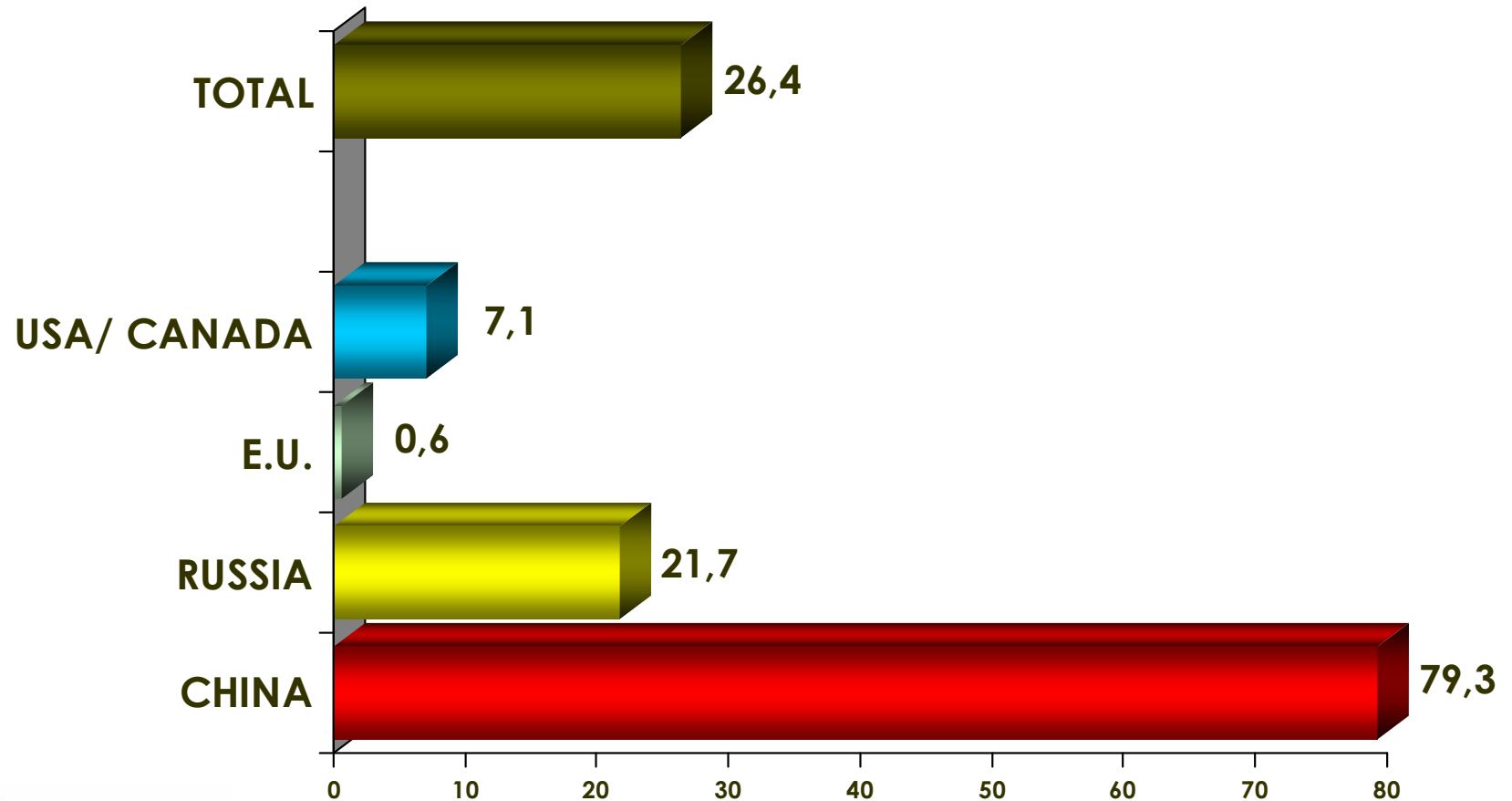

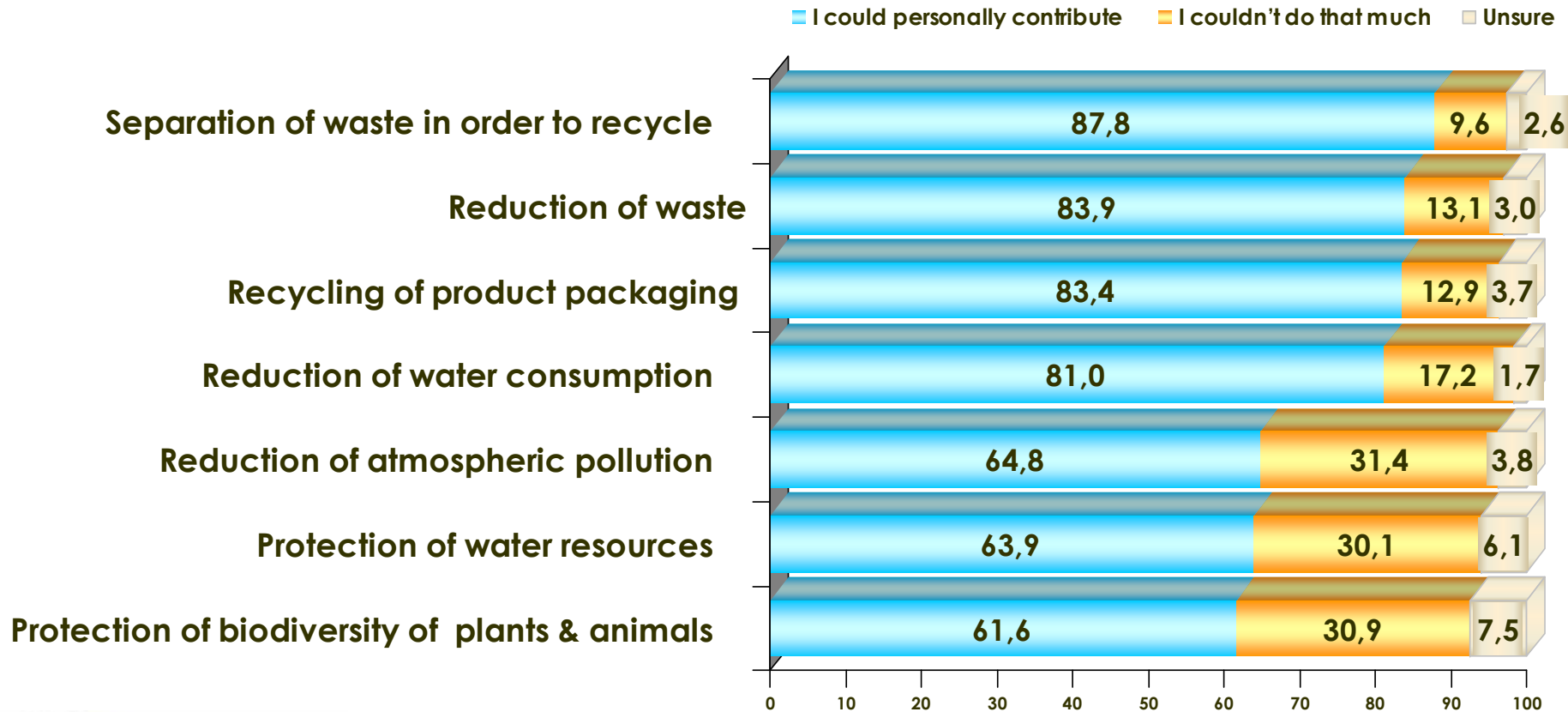

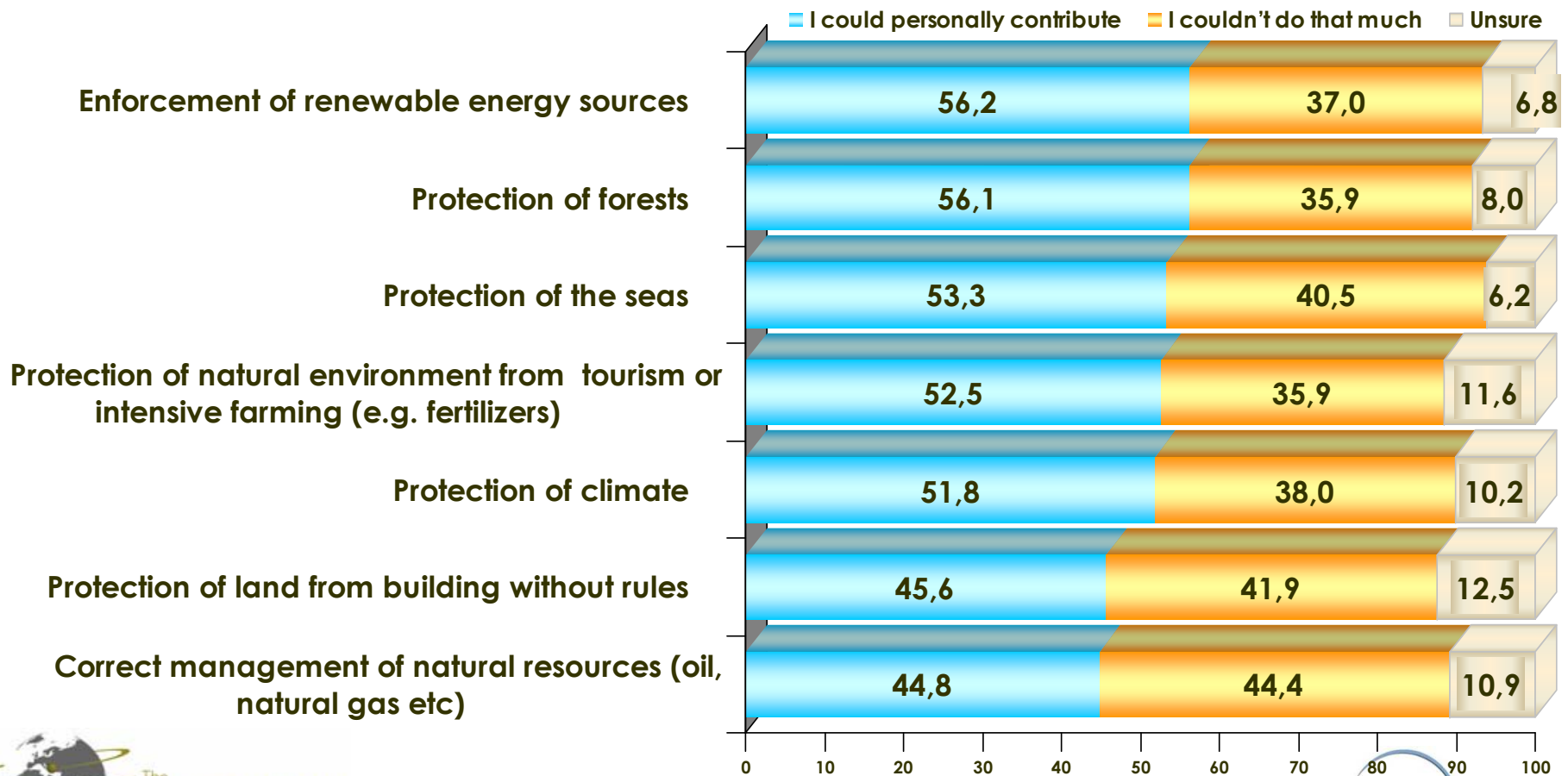
