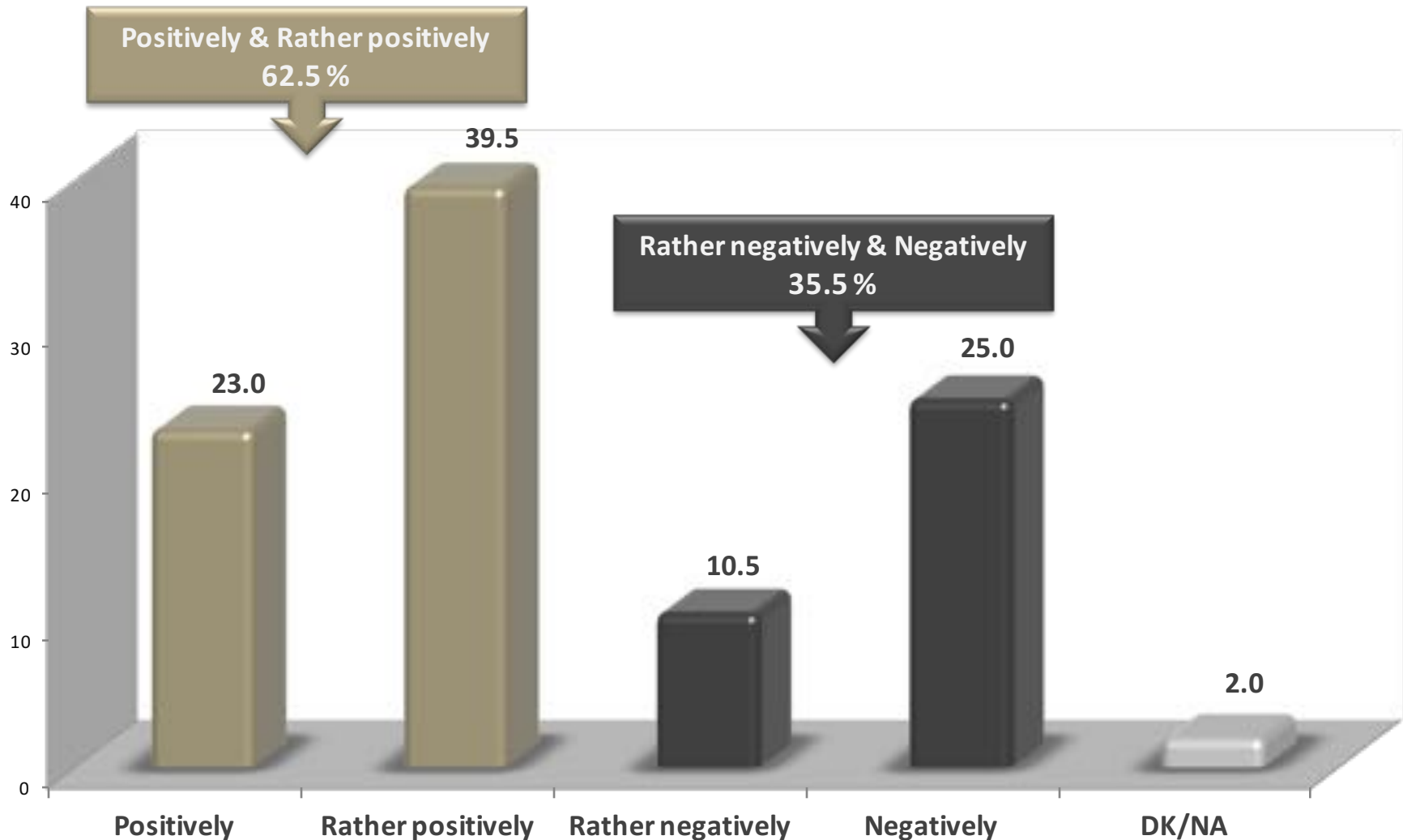

## STANCE ON THE COMPLETION OF THE PROGRAM REVIEW

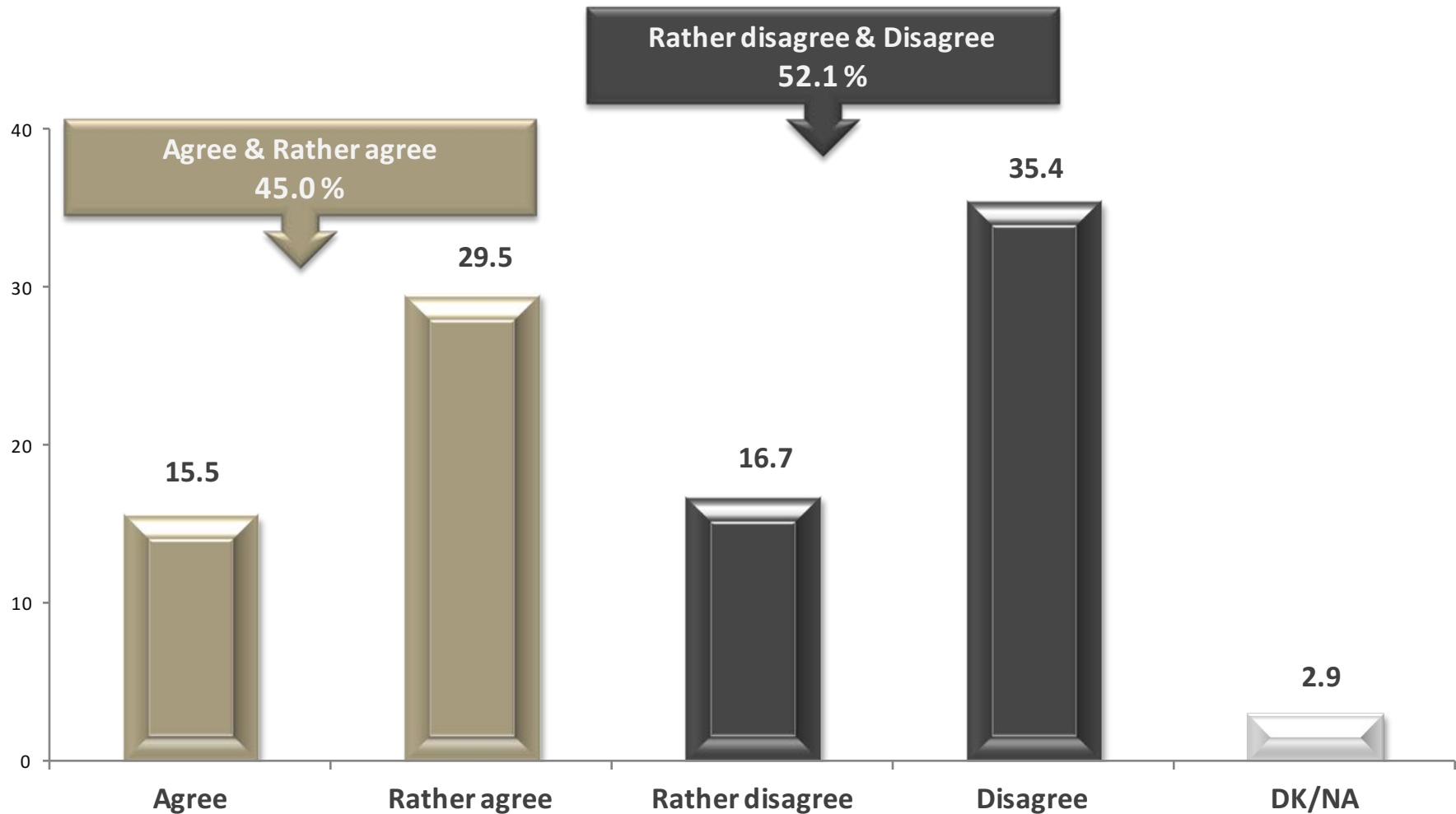

# COMPLETION OF THE PROGRAM REVIEW & STABILITY

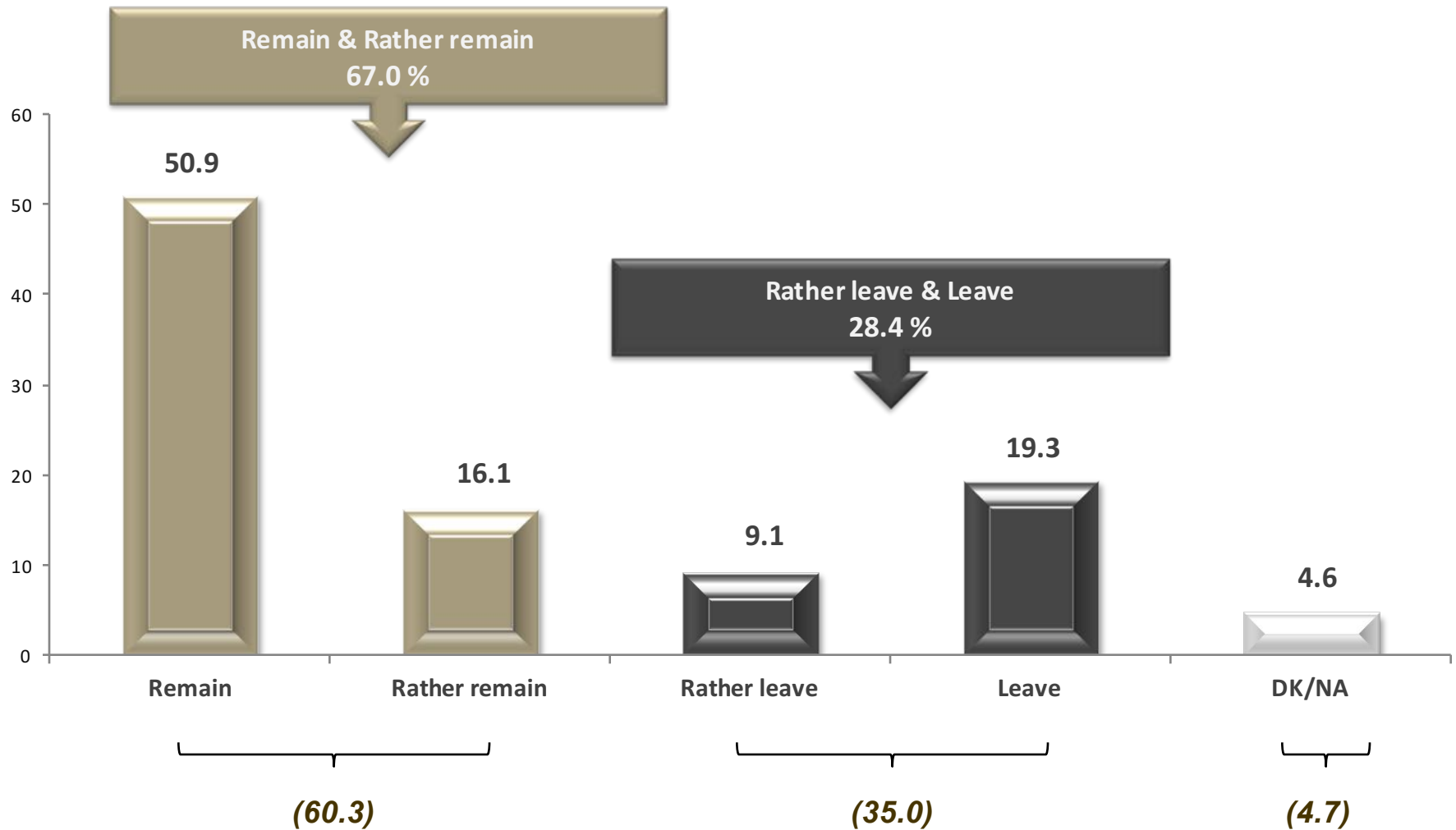
Do you agree or disagree with the following opinion?

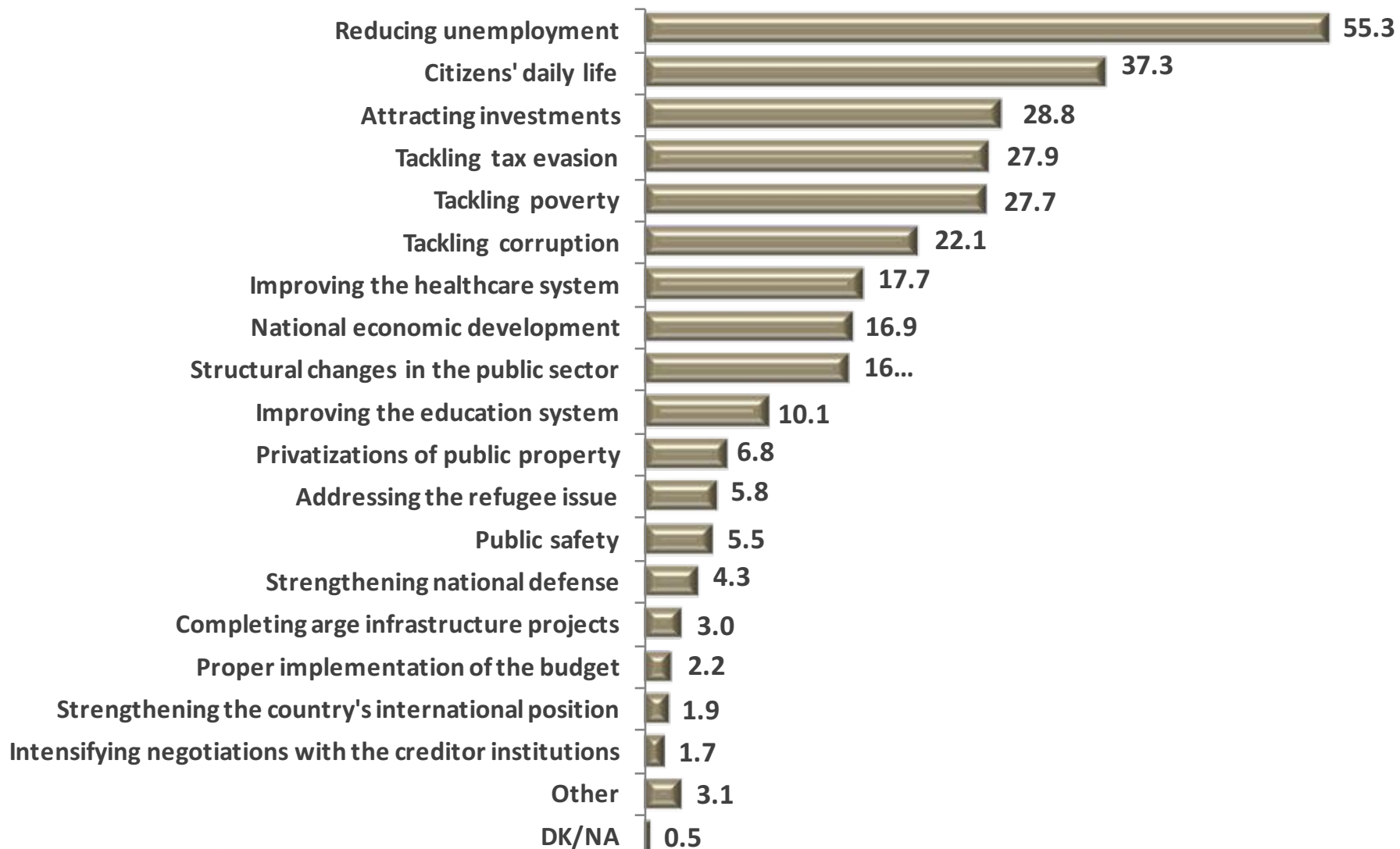

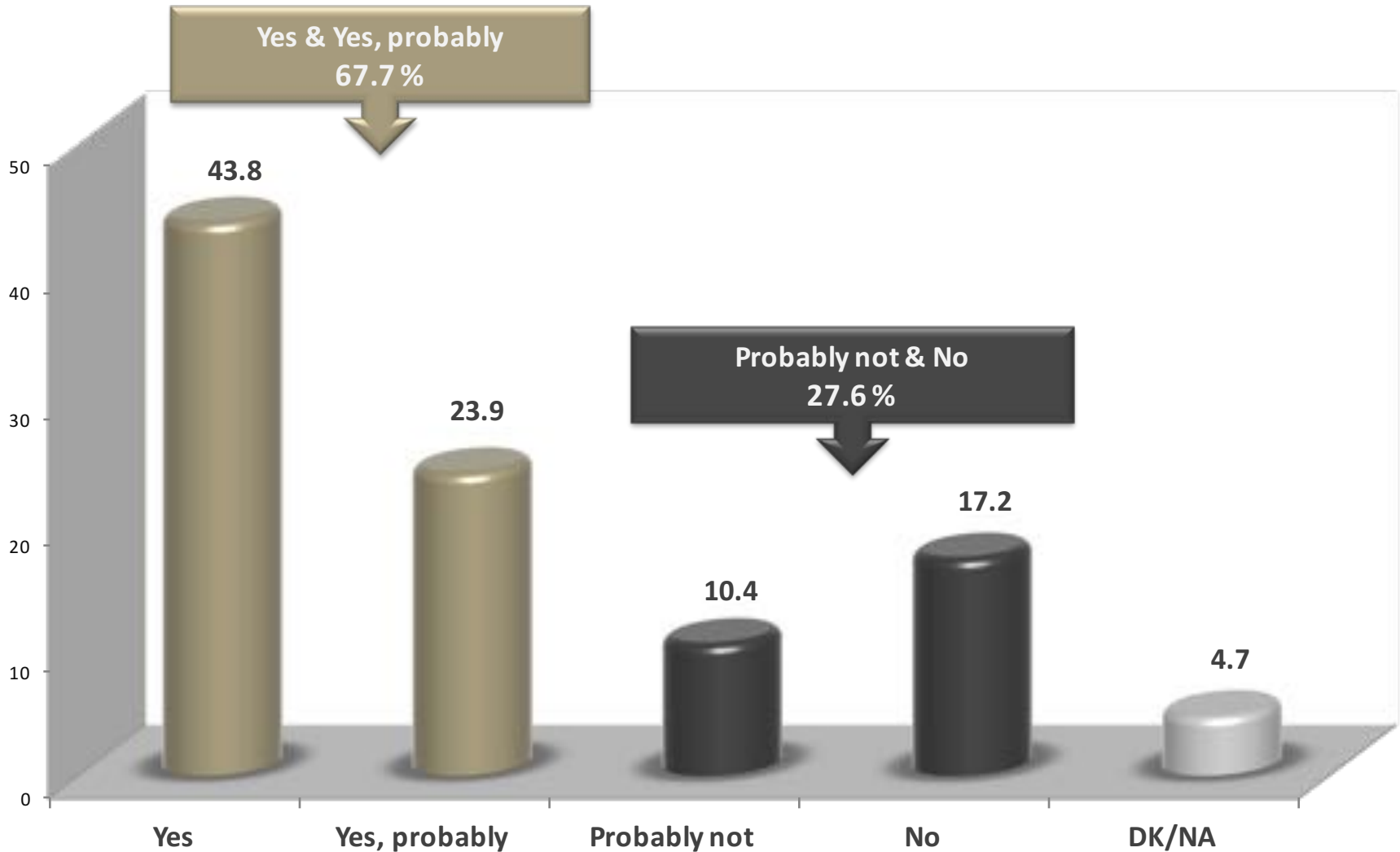
After closing the first program review, which policy areas do you think should constitute the government's priorities for the near future?

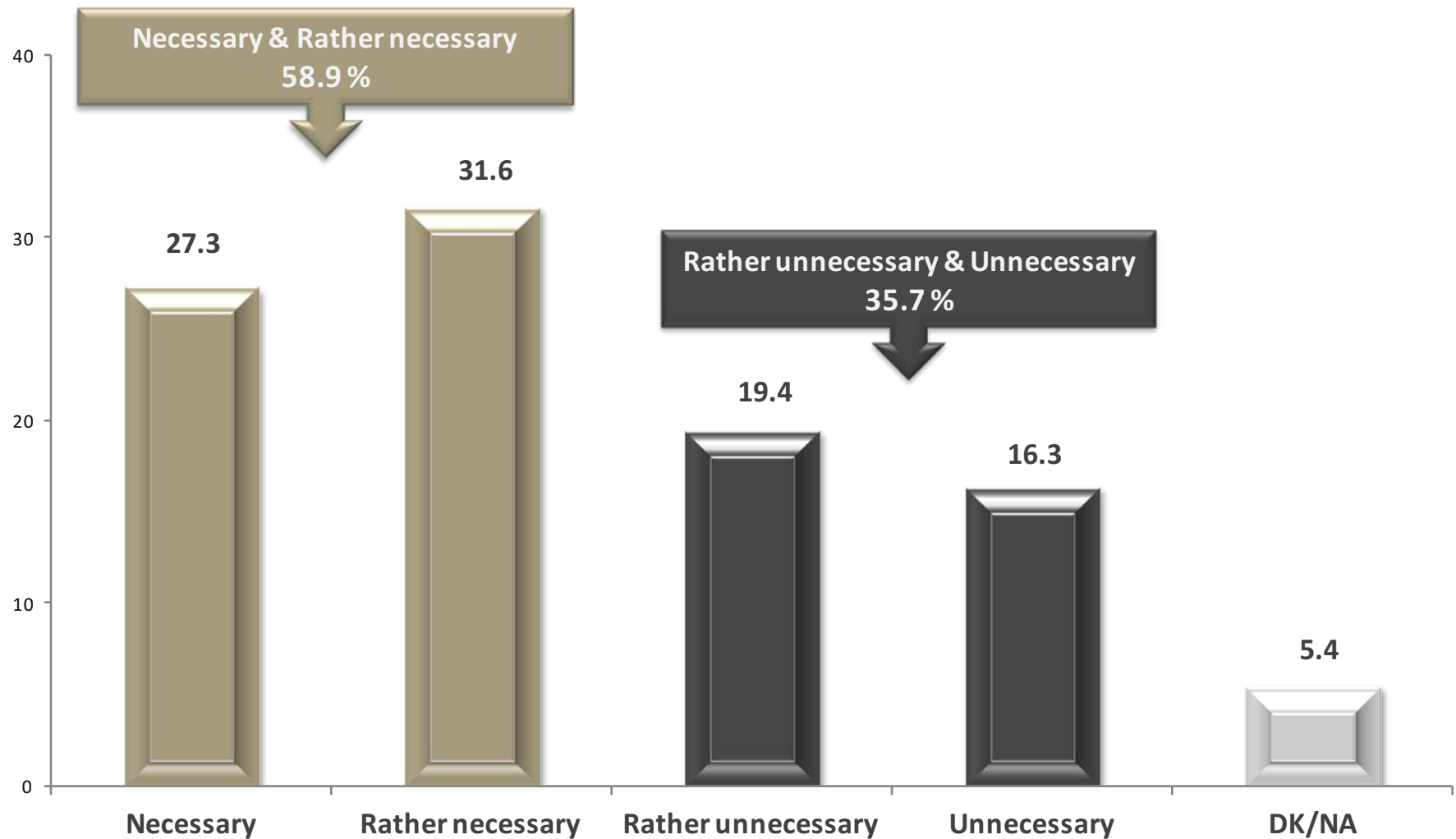
Do you agree with establishing a more proportional electoral system?

Do you believe that a constitutional amendment is today:

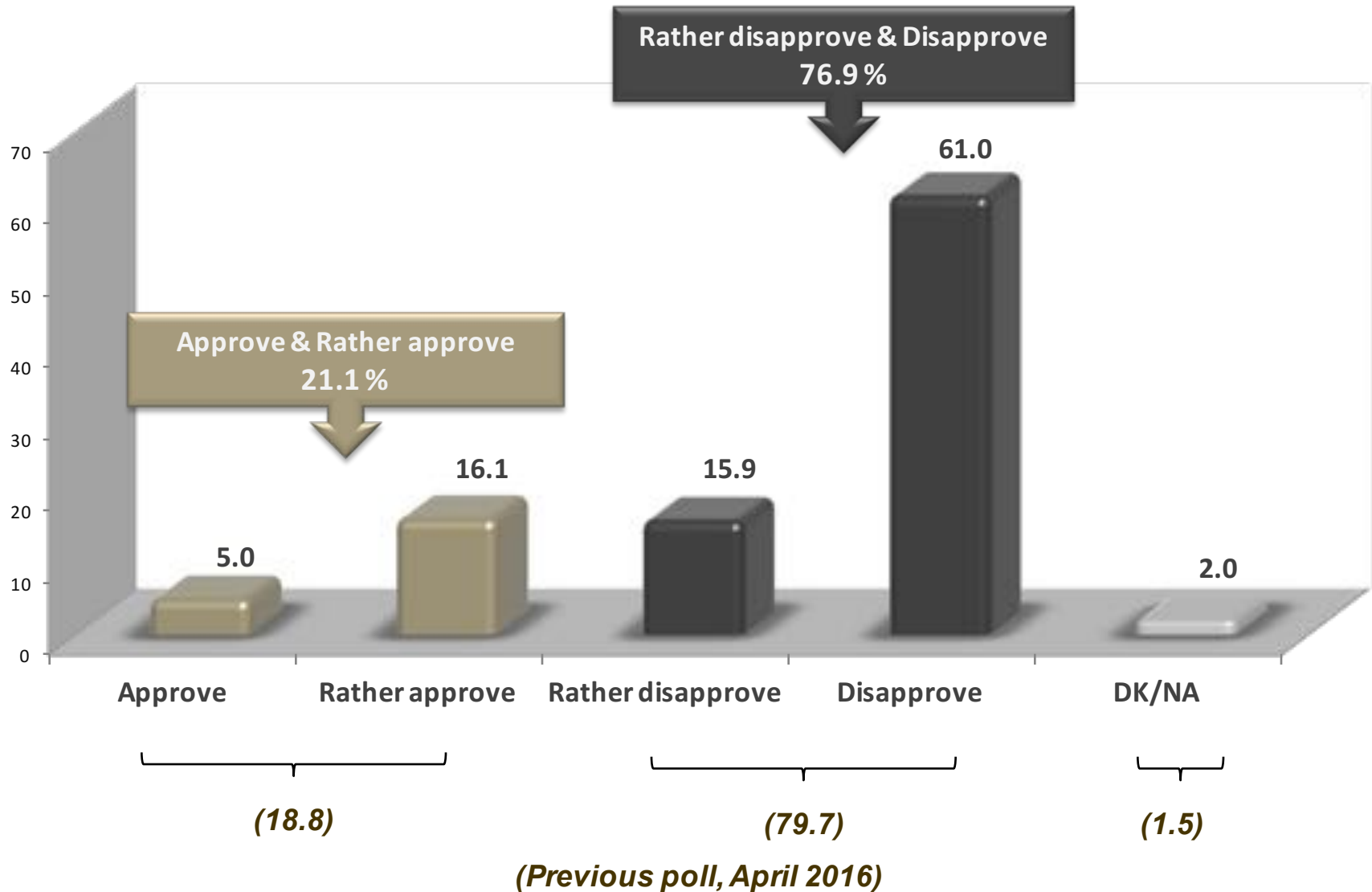

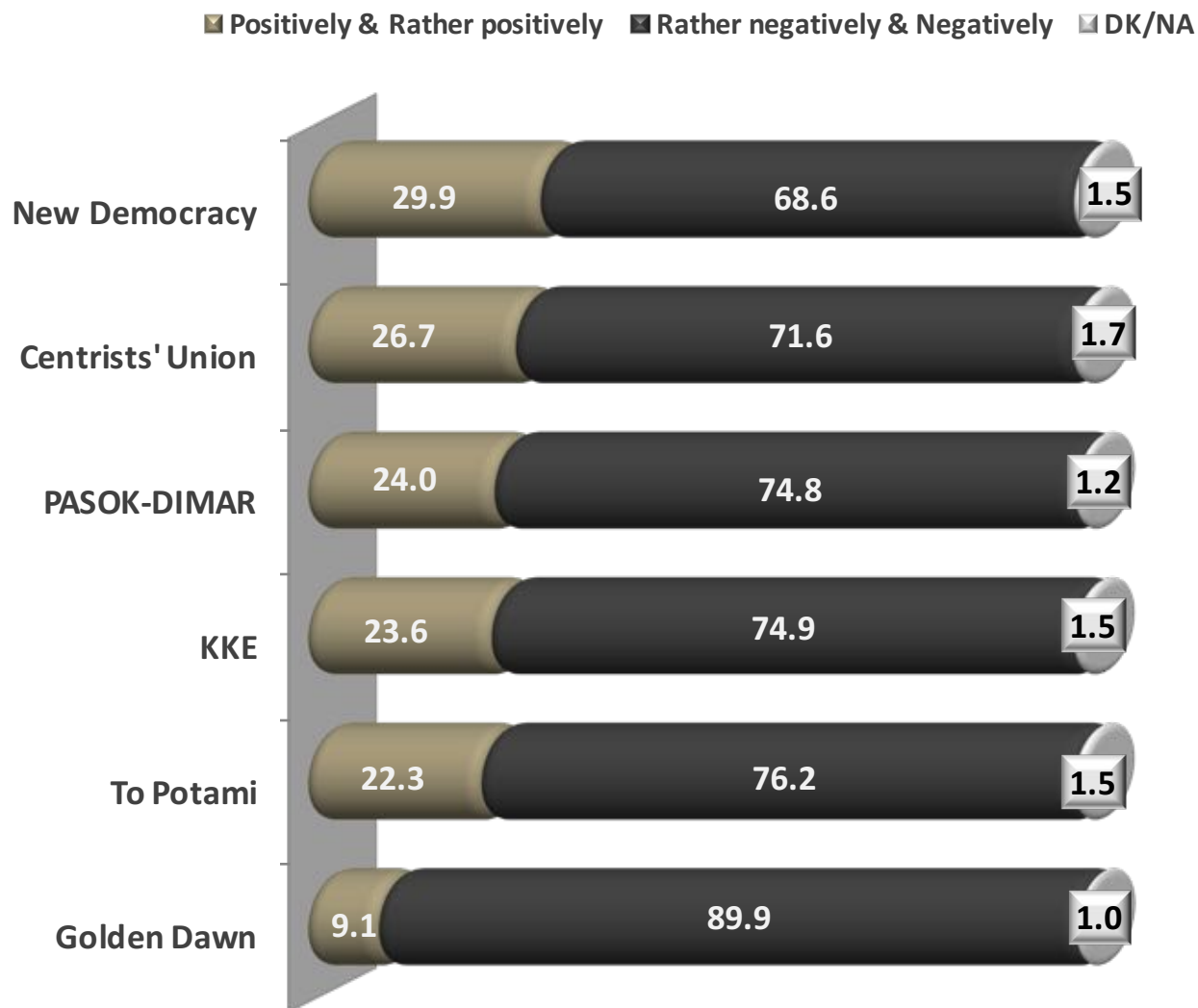
## GOVERNMENT'S JOB APPROVAL

Overall, do you approve or disapprove of the job the government is doing so far?



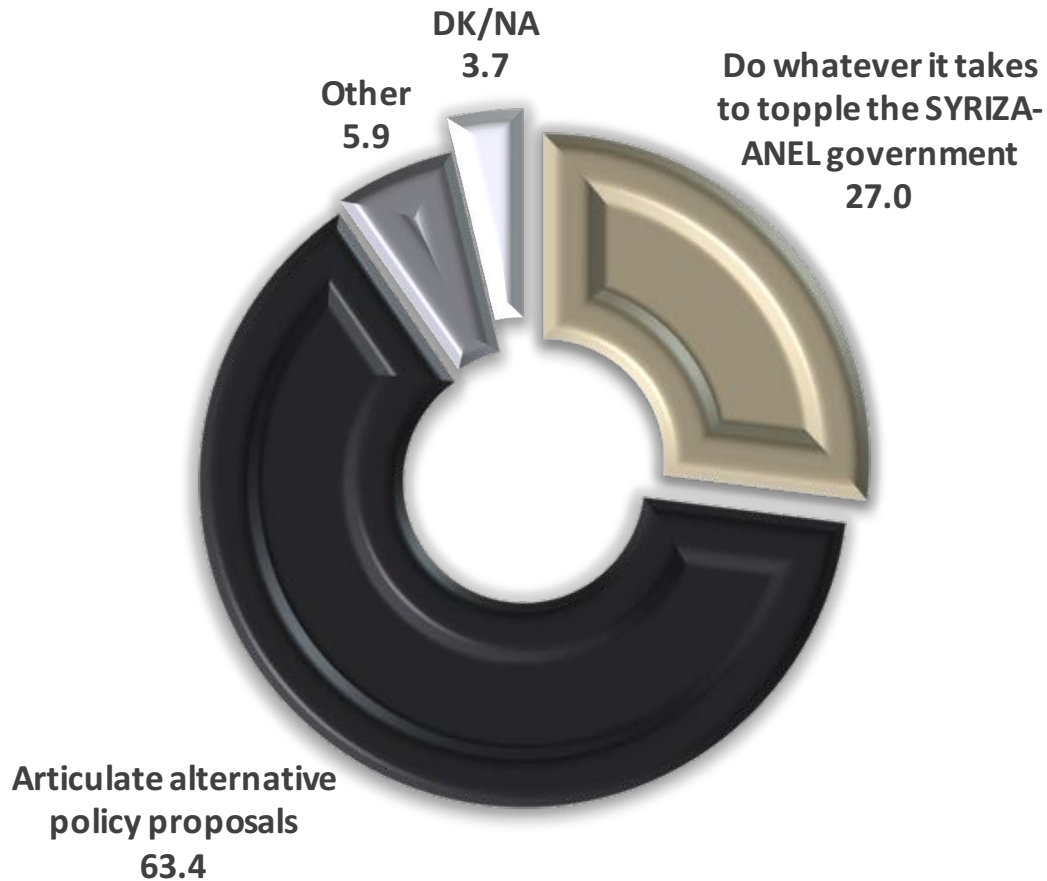
## OPOSITION PARTIES' JOB APPROVAL

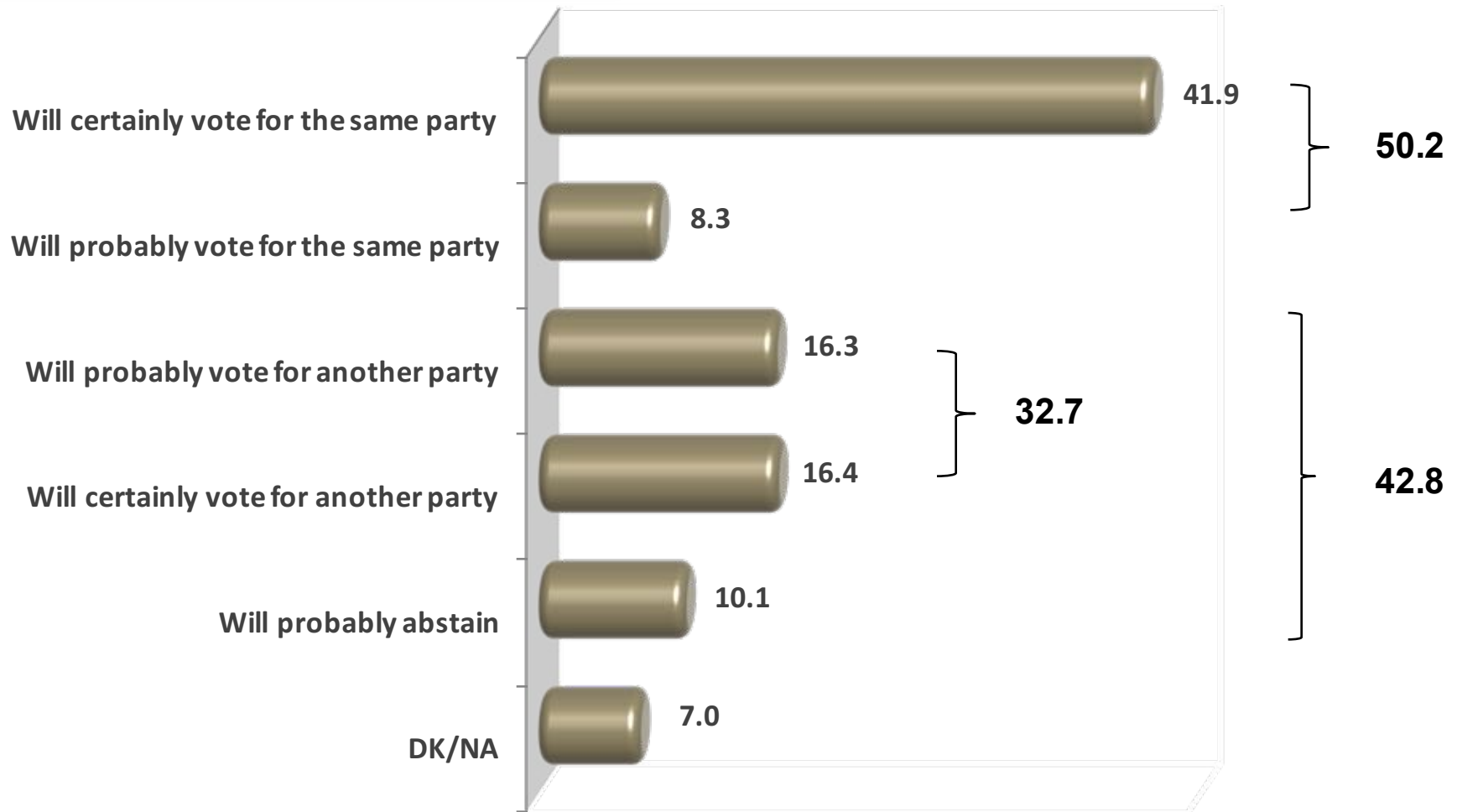
In the phase we are today, what should be the priority for the opposition? To do whatever it takes to take down the SYRIZA-ANEL government or to articulate alternative policy proposals?

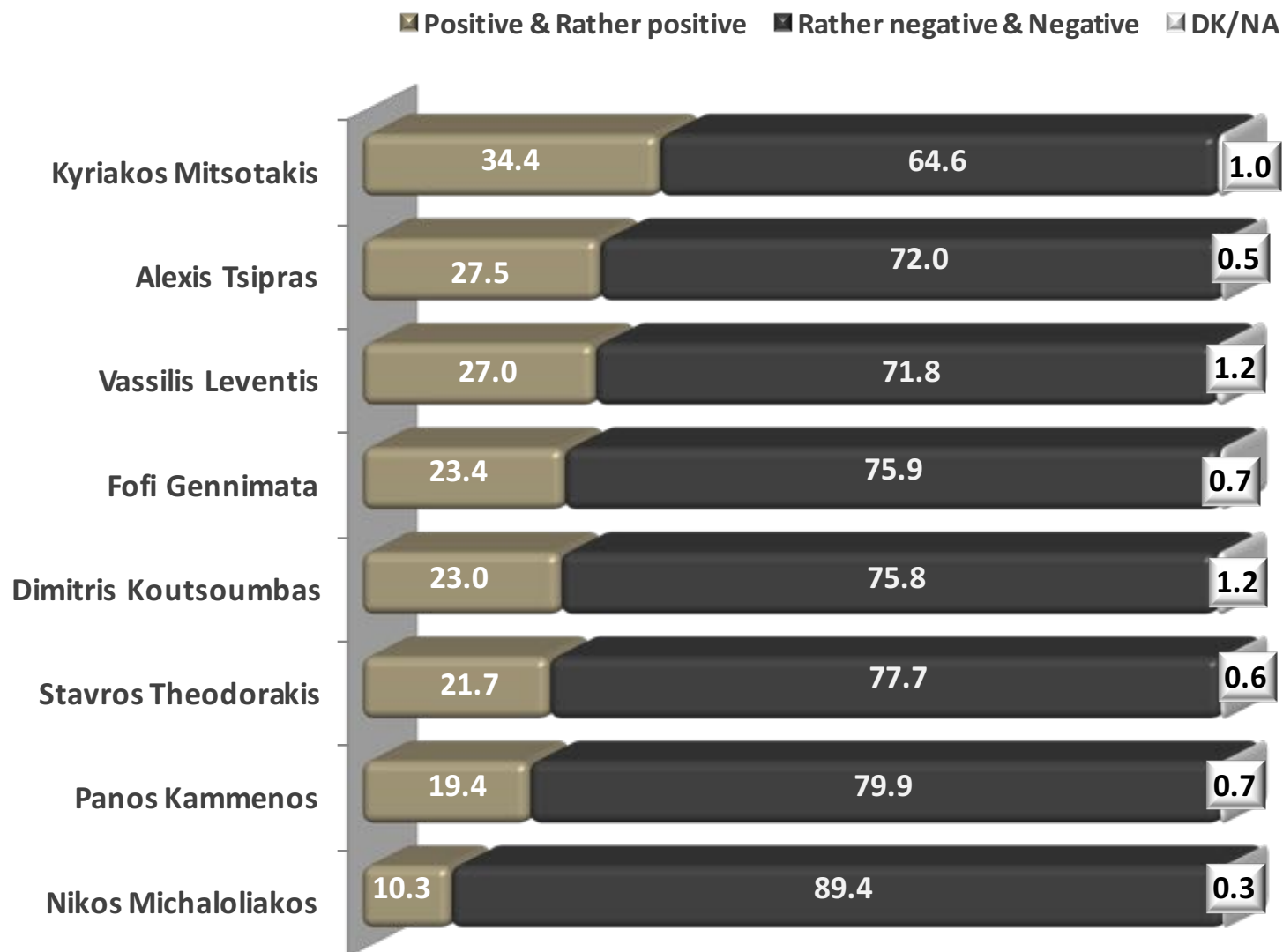

What is your opinion of each of the following political leaders?



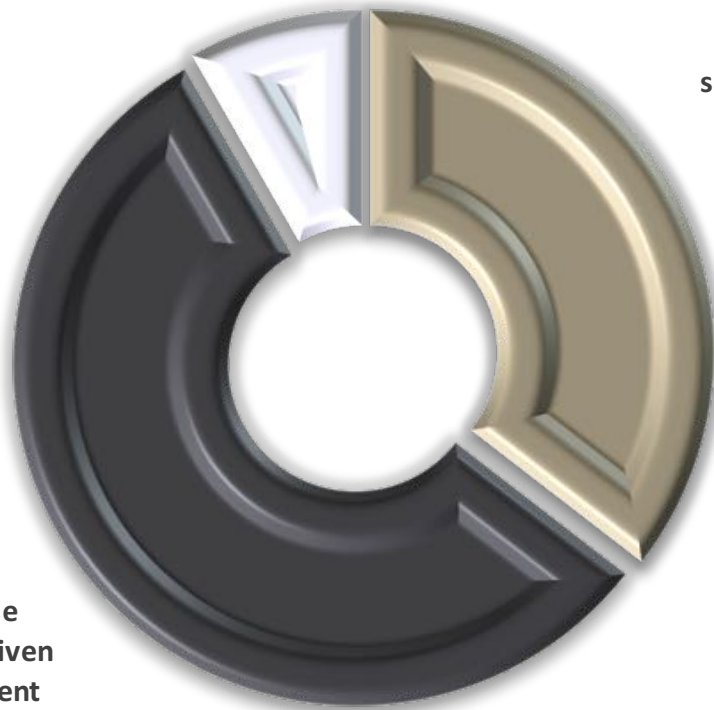

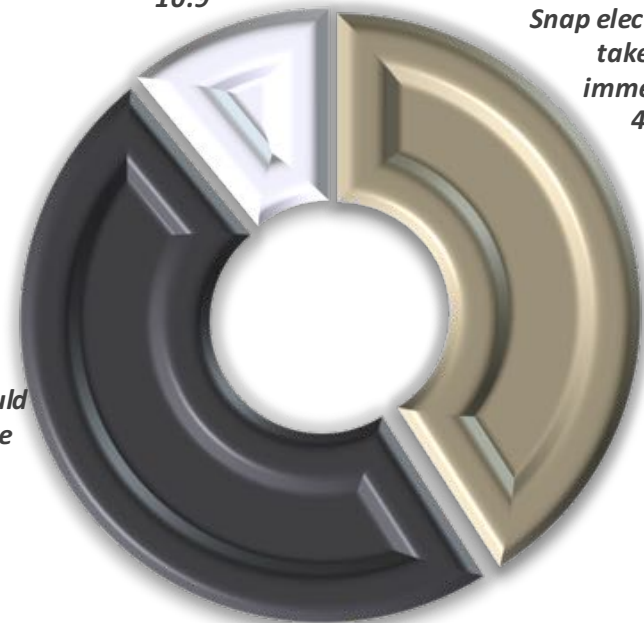

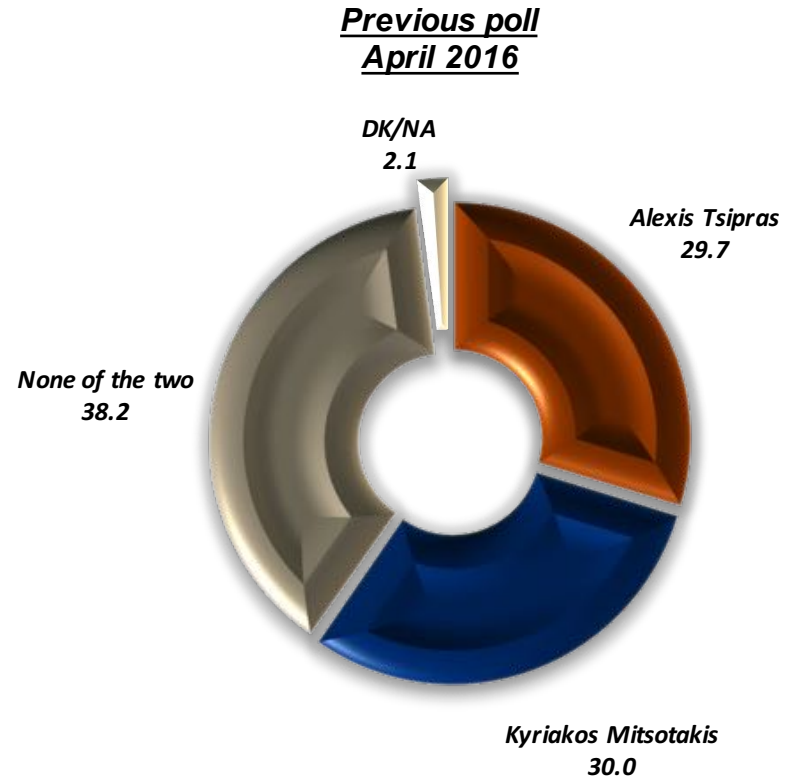

## MOST SUITABLE FOR PRIME MINISTER

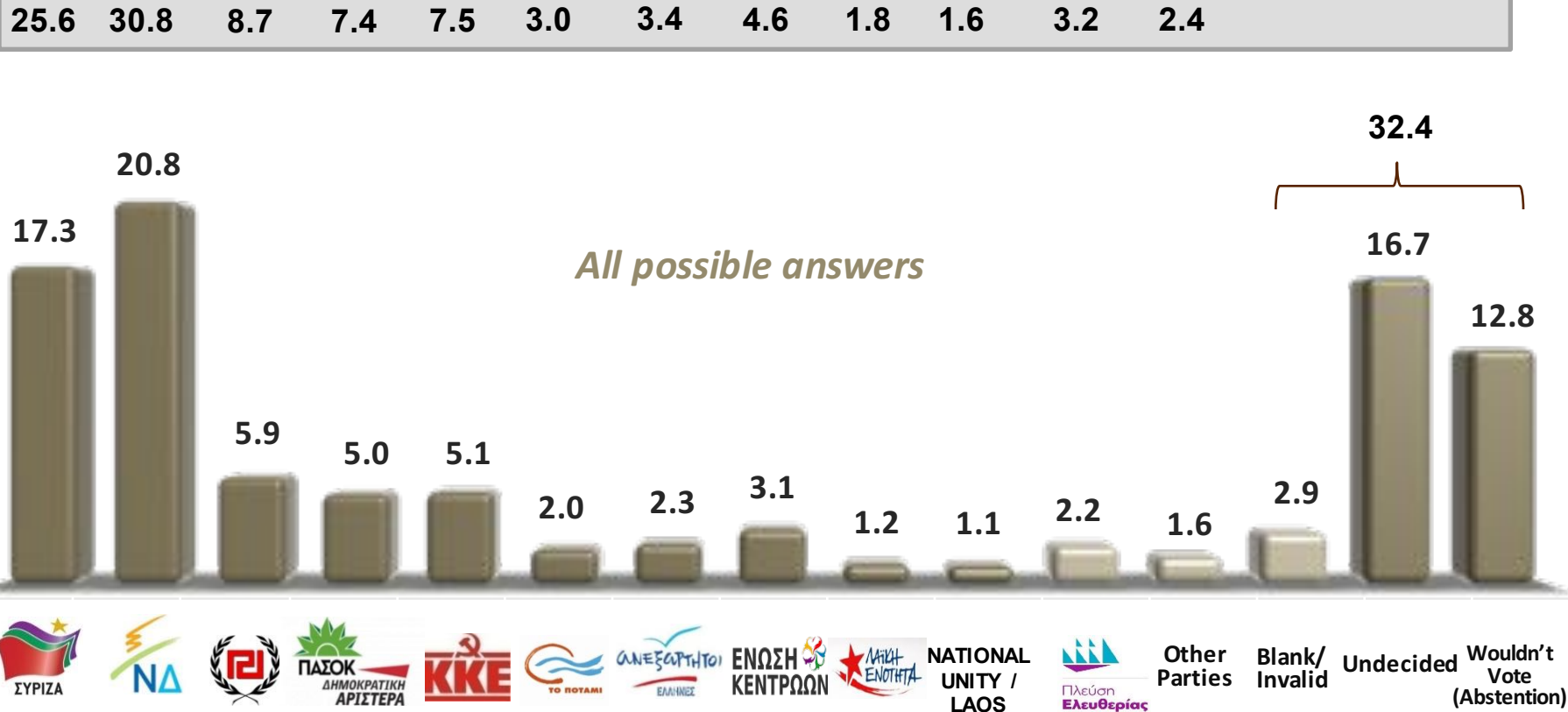
Between Alexis Tsipras and Kyriakos Mitsotakis, in your opinion, who is more suitable for the Prime Minister's job?

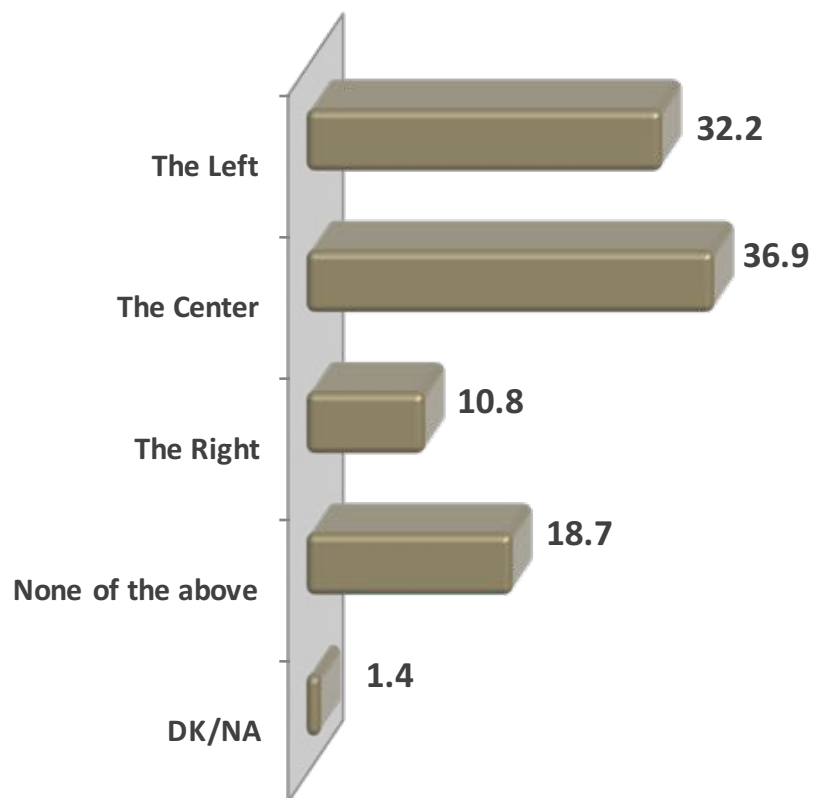

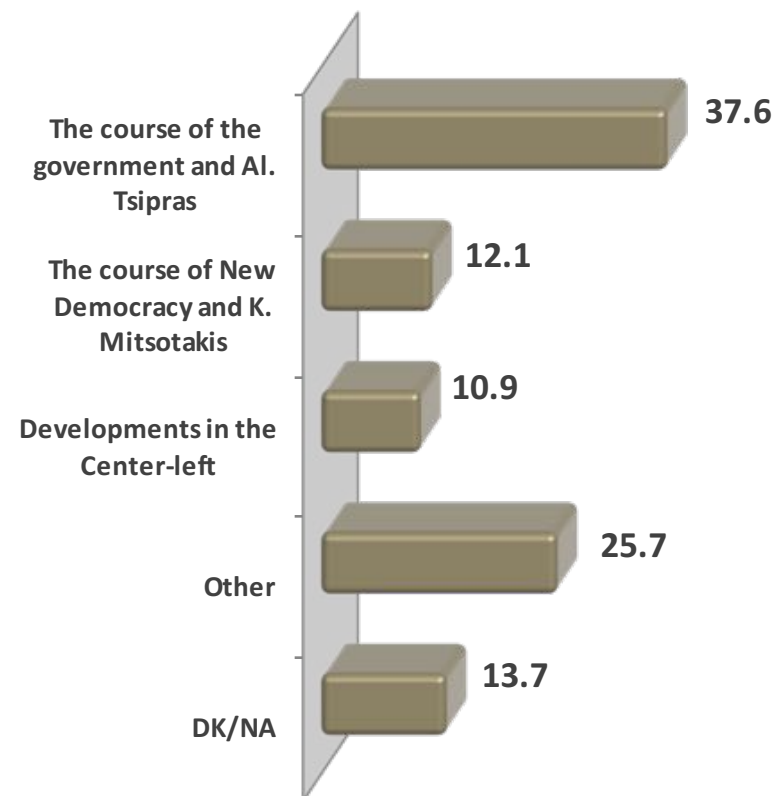
### Political identity

*Generally speaking, your political opinions lean more towards:*



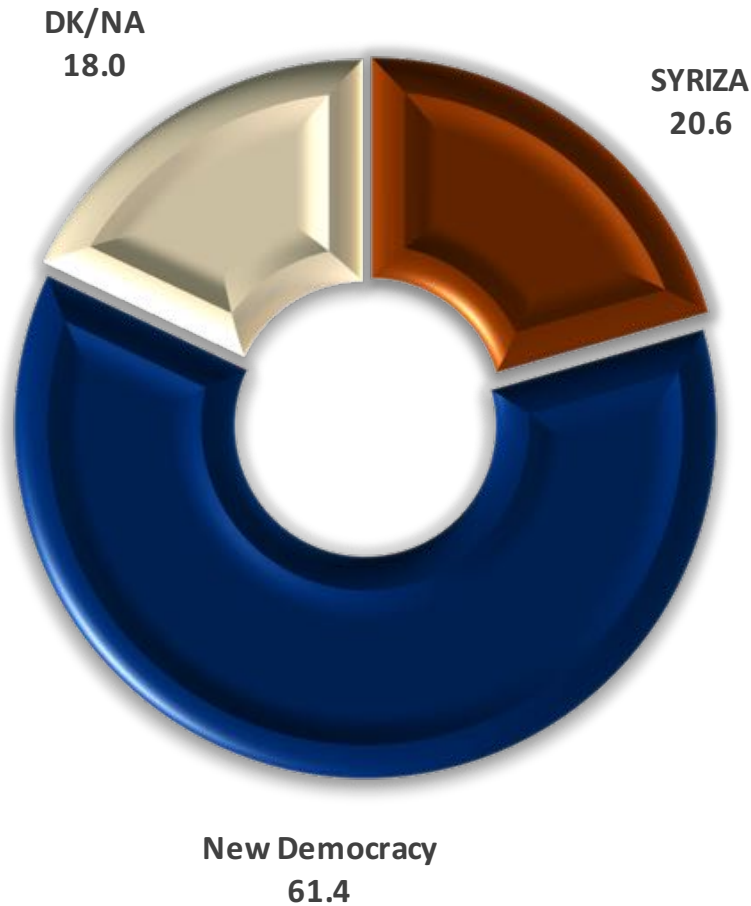
### Vote criterion
