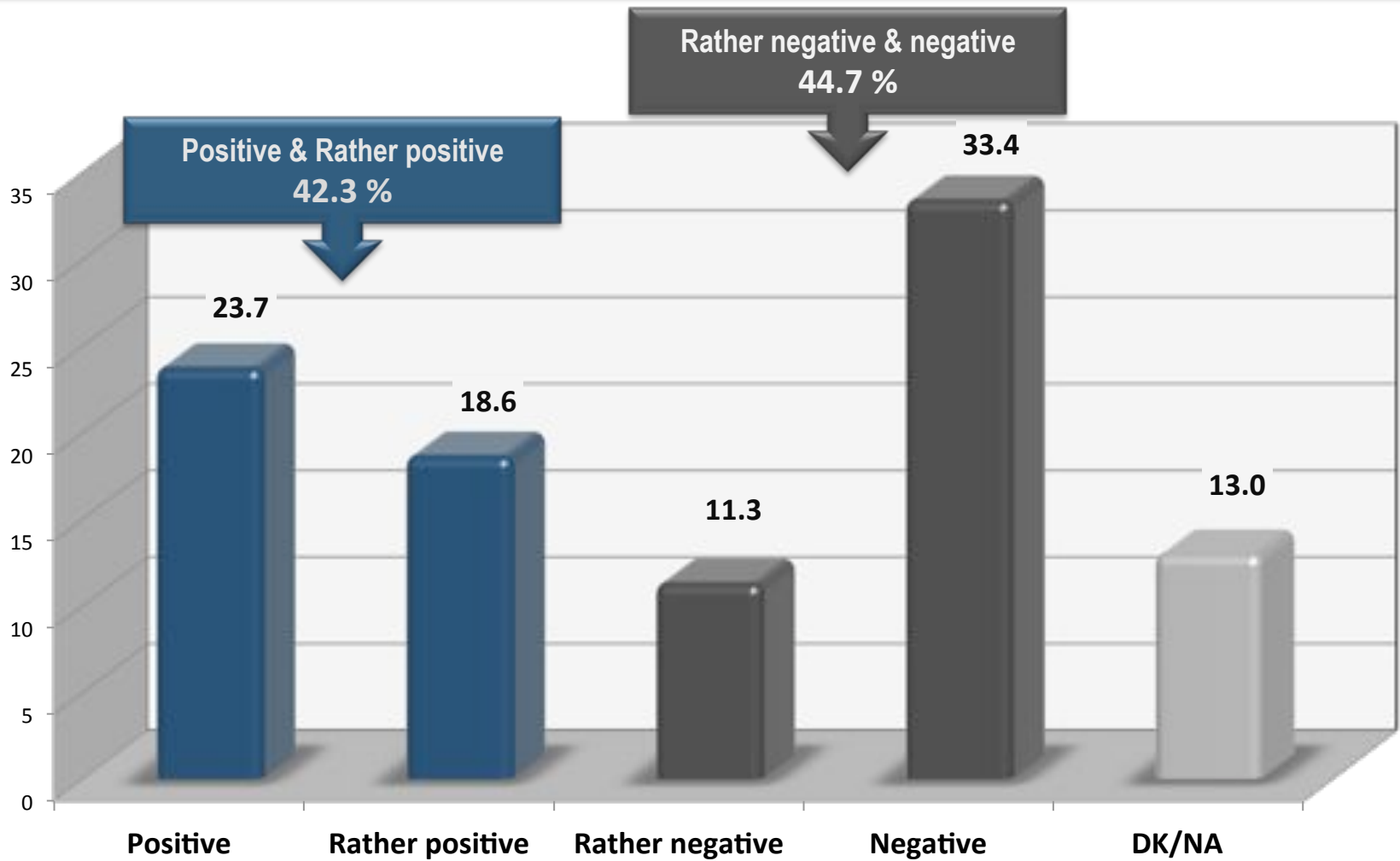

Sampling Method	Multistage sampling using quotas with respect to geographical distribution, gender, and age of the population. The survey's results are weighted based on the June 2012 election results
Data Collection Method	Telephone Interviews
Standard Error	3.08% at the 95% confidence interval

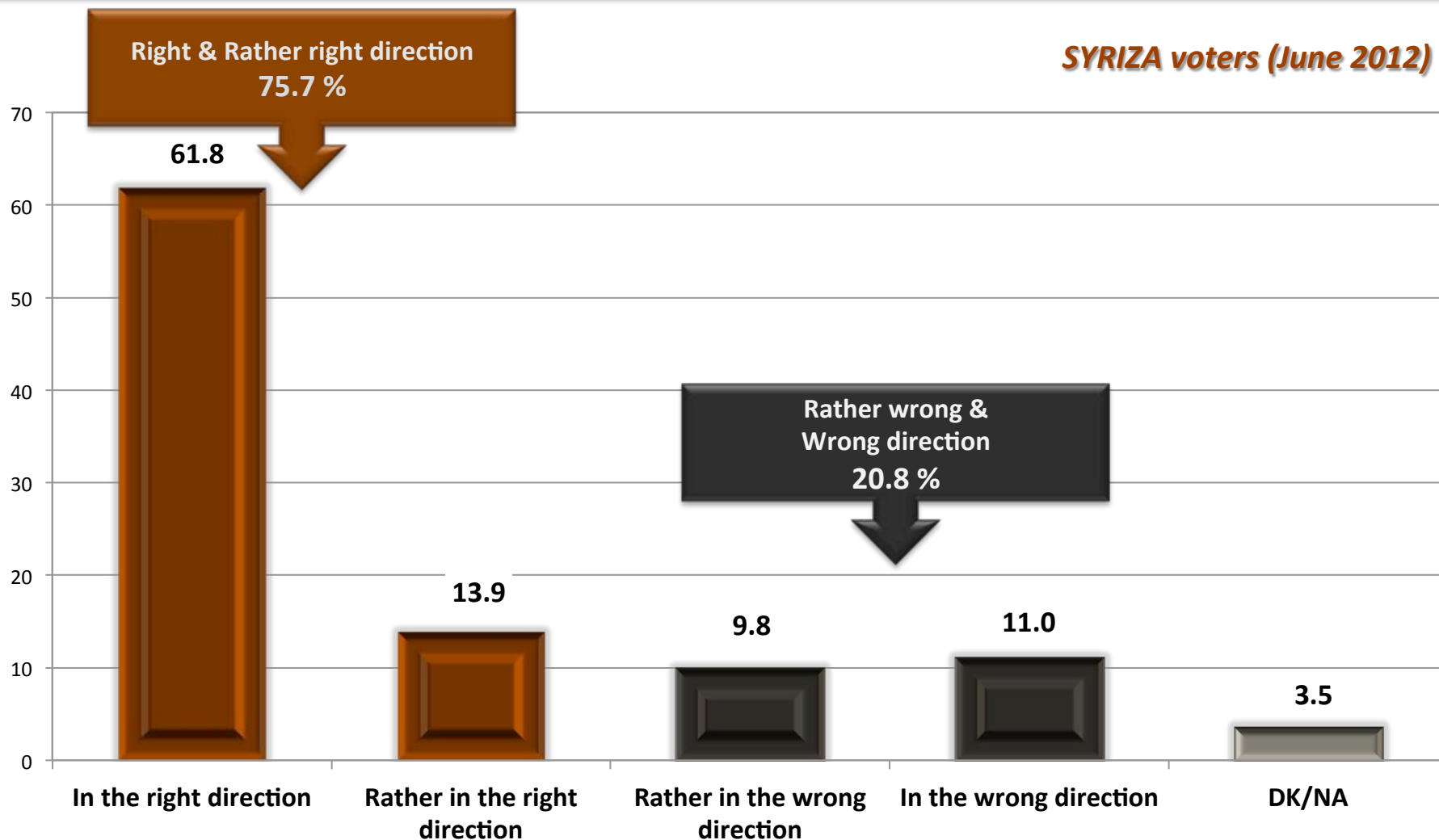

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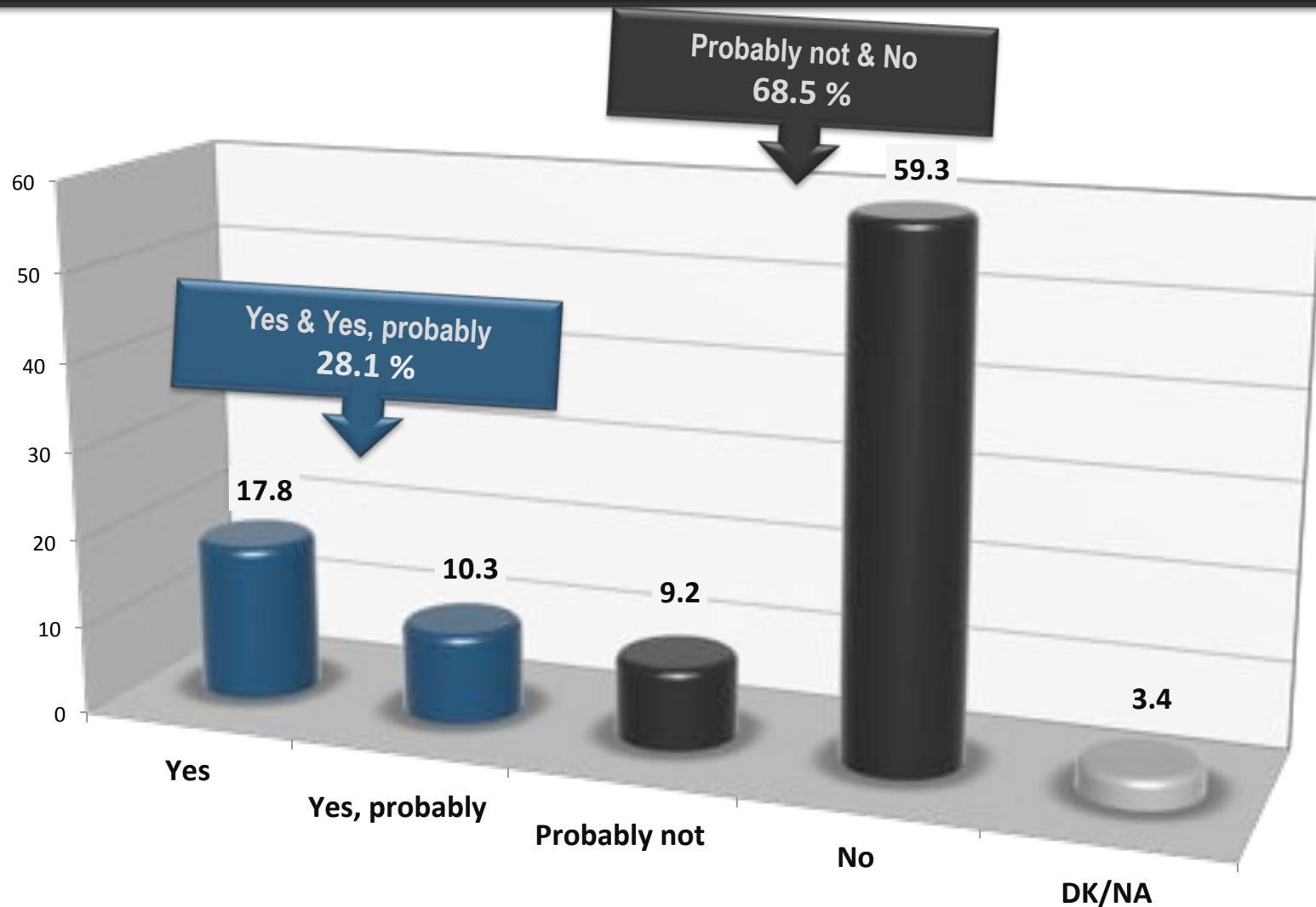




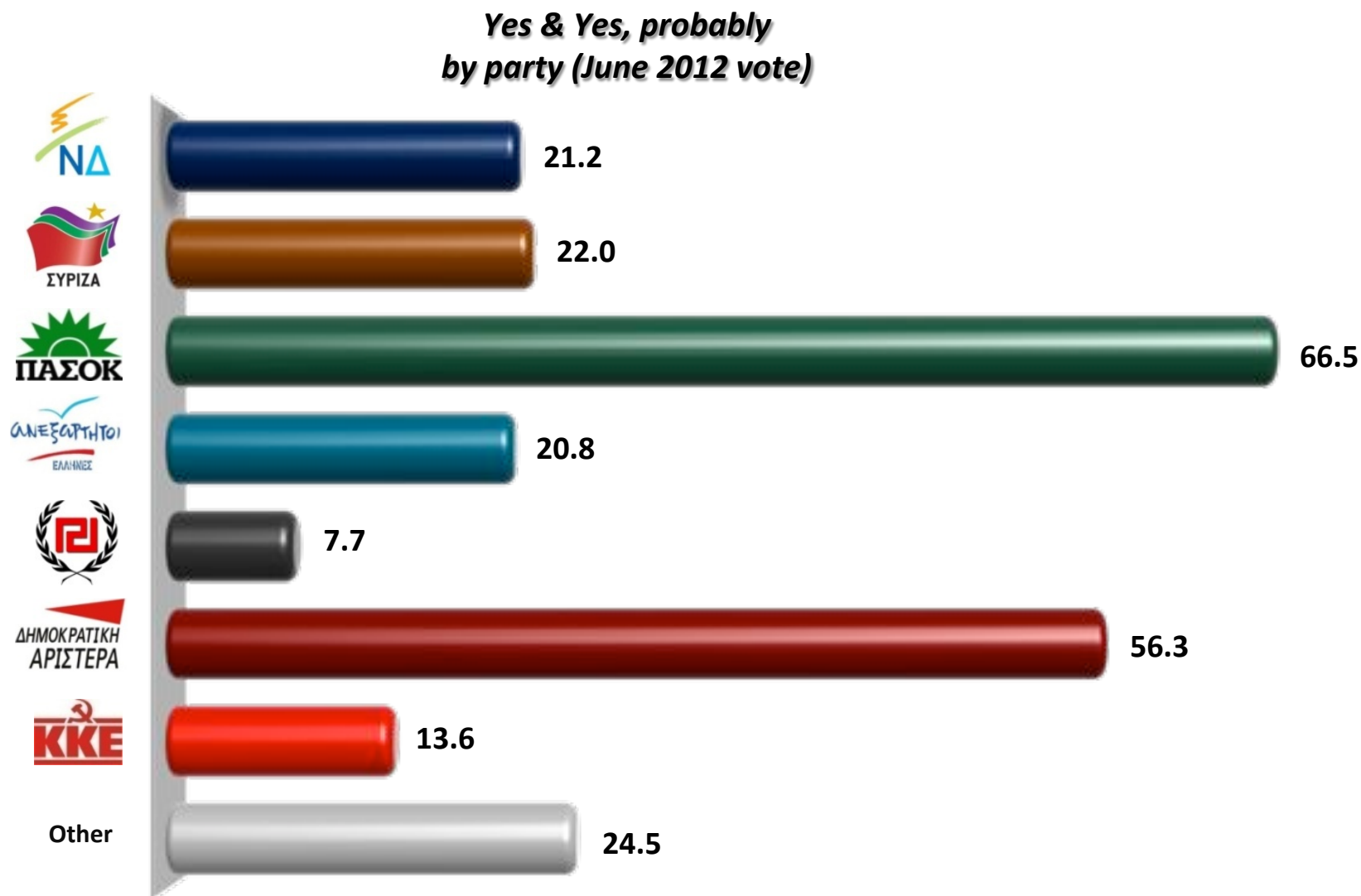

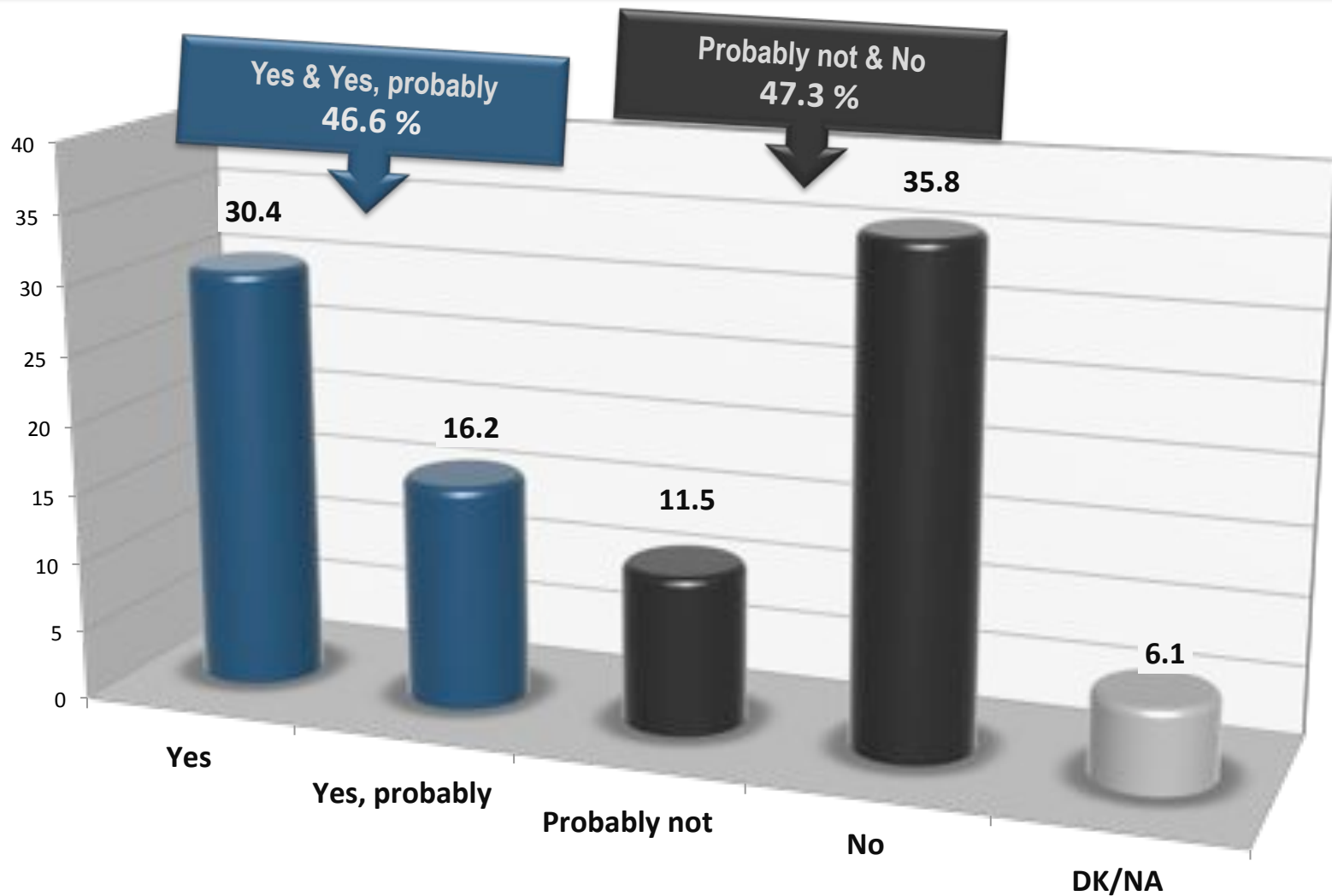

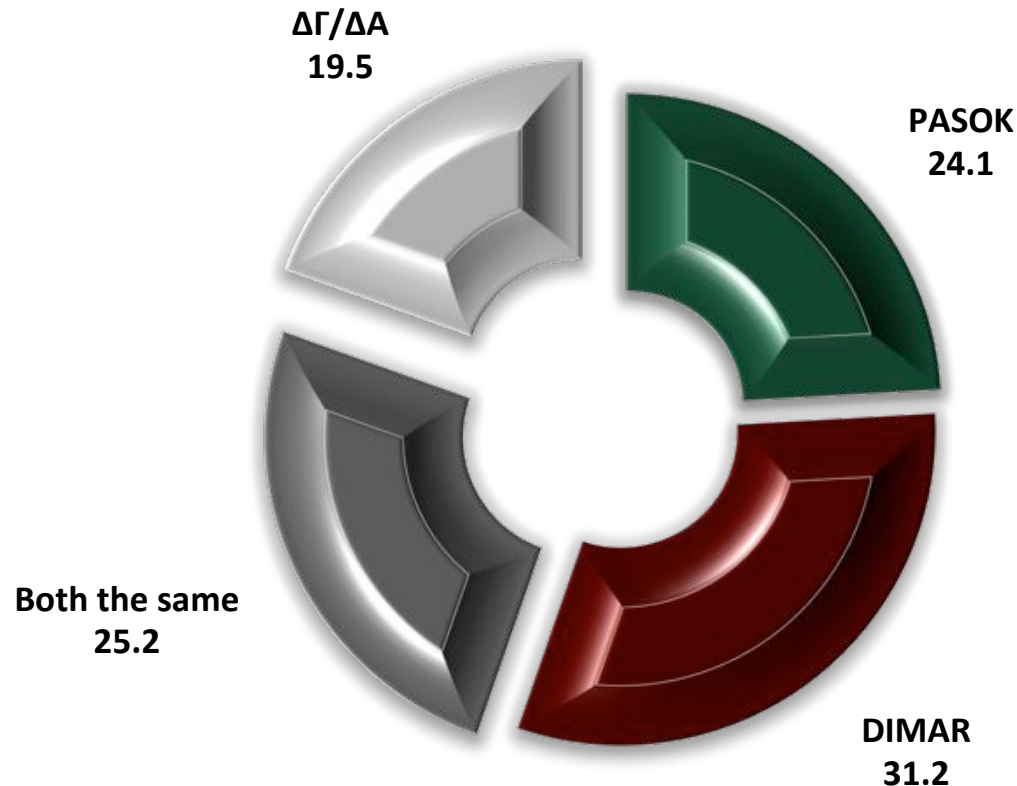
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You believe that until the next general elections, the above parties and other movements from the center-left should form a new party all together?



Until now, which of the two parties, PASOK or DIMAR, is more responsible for the failure to form a new center-left political alliance?

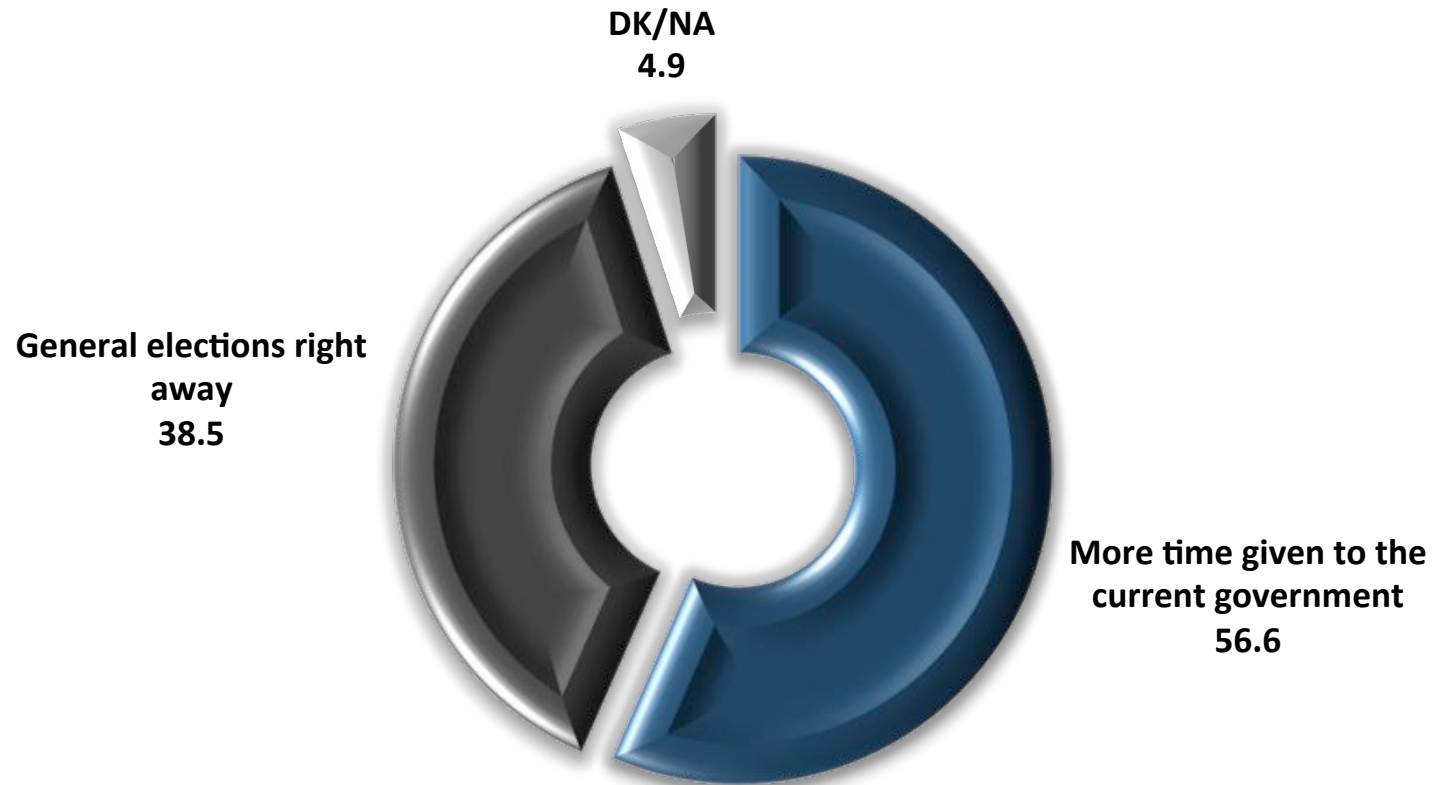




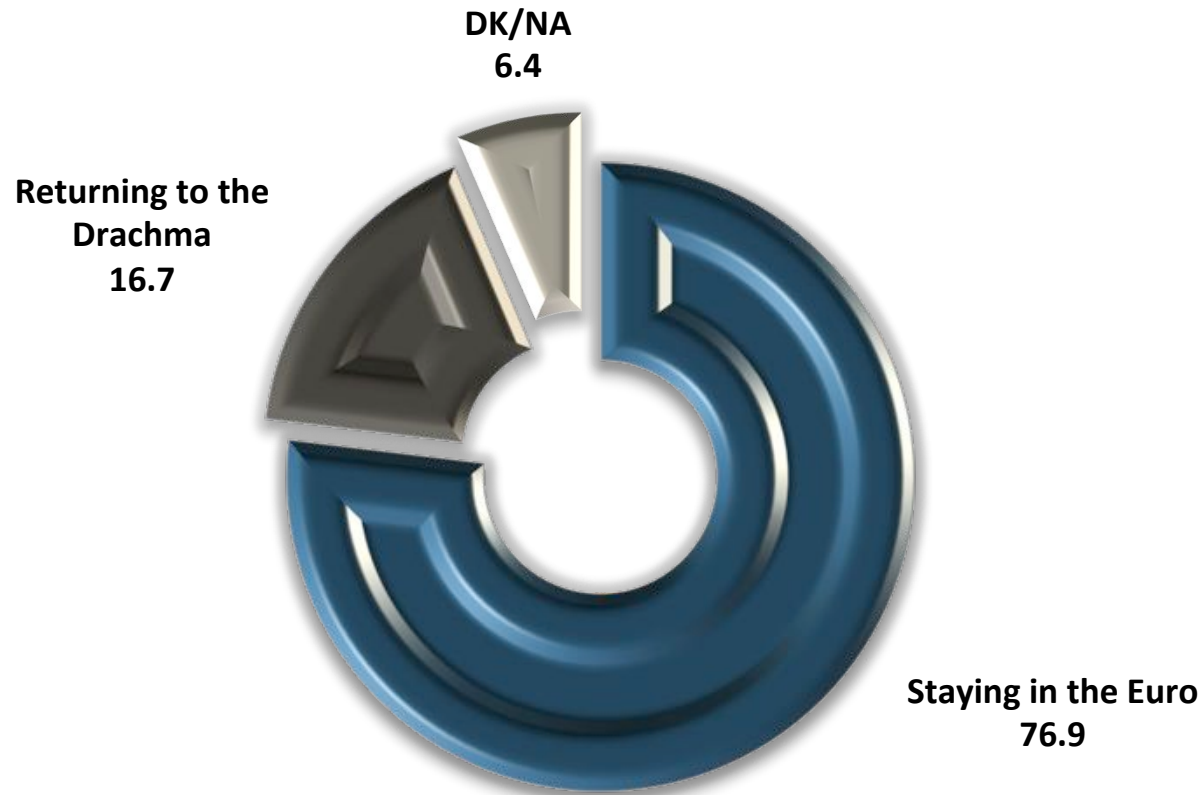

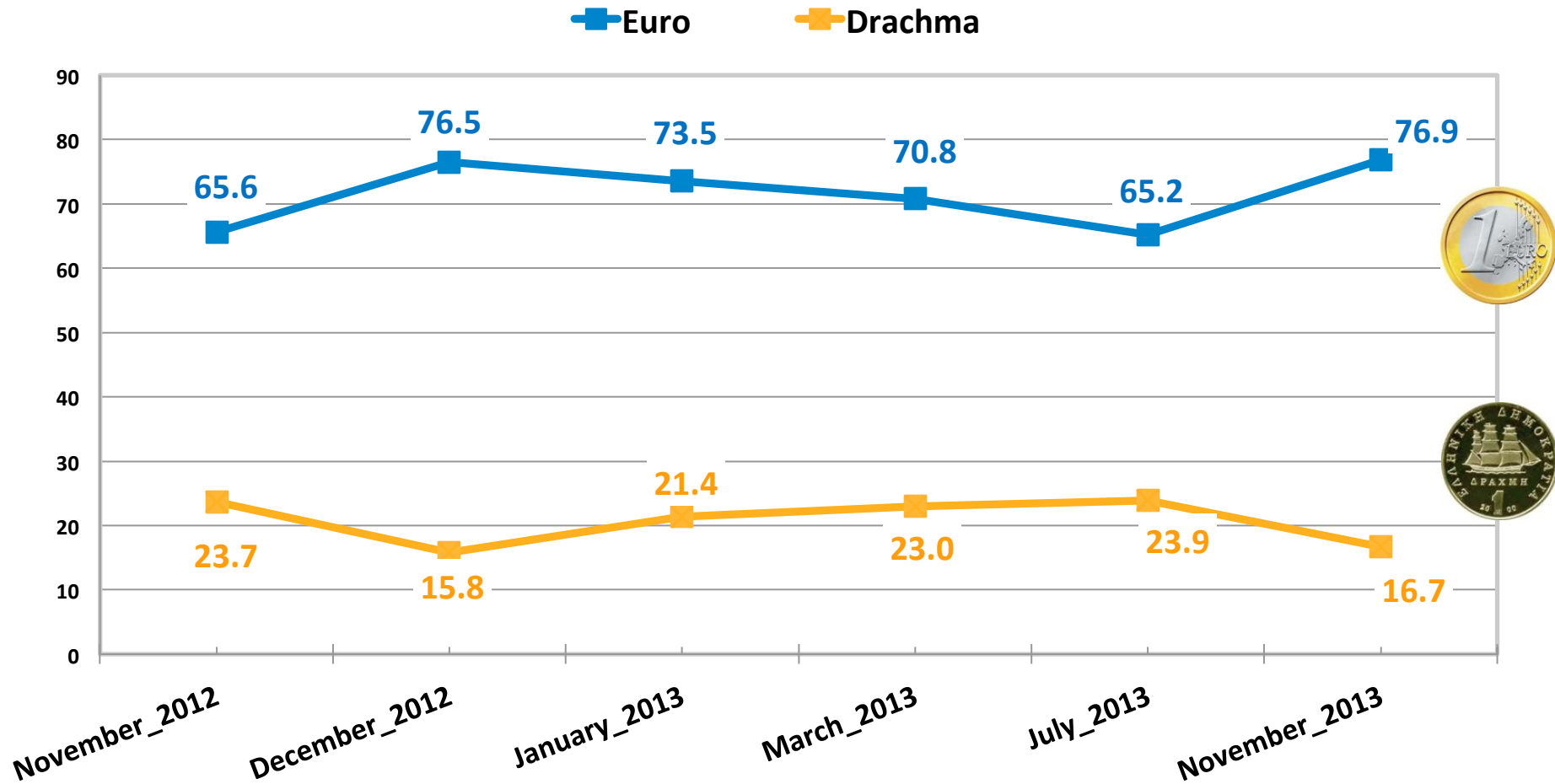
**Which of the following would you prefer:

Staying in the Euro or returning to the Drachma?

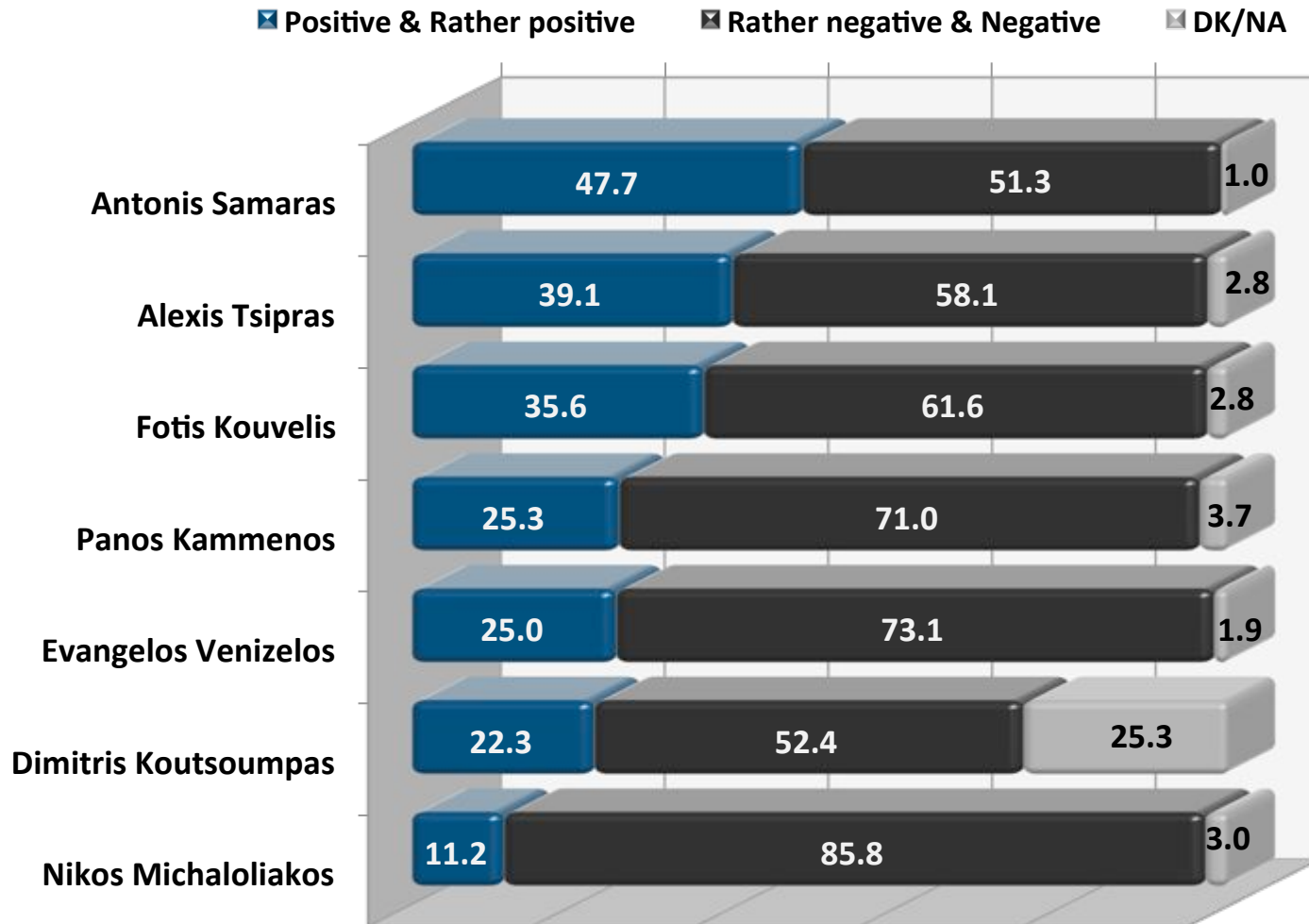


Which of the following would you prefer:

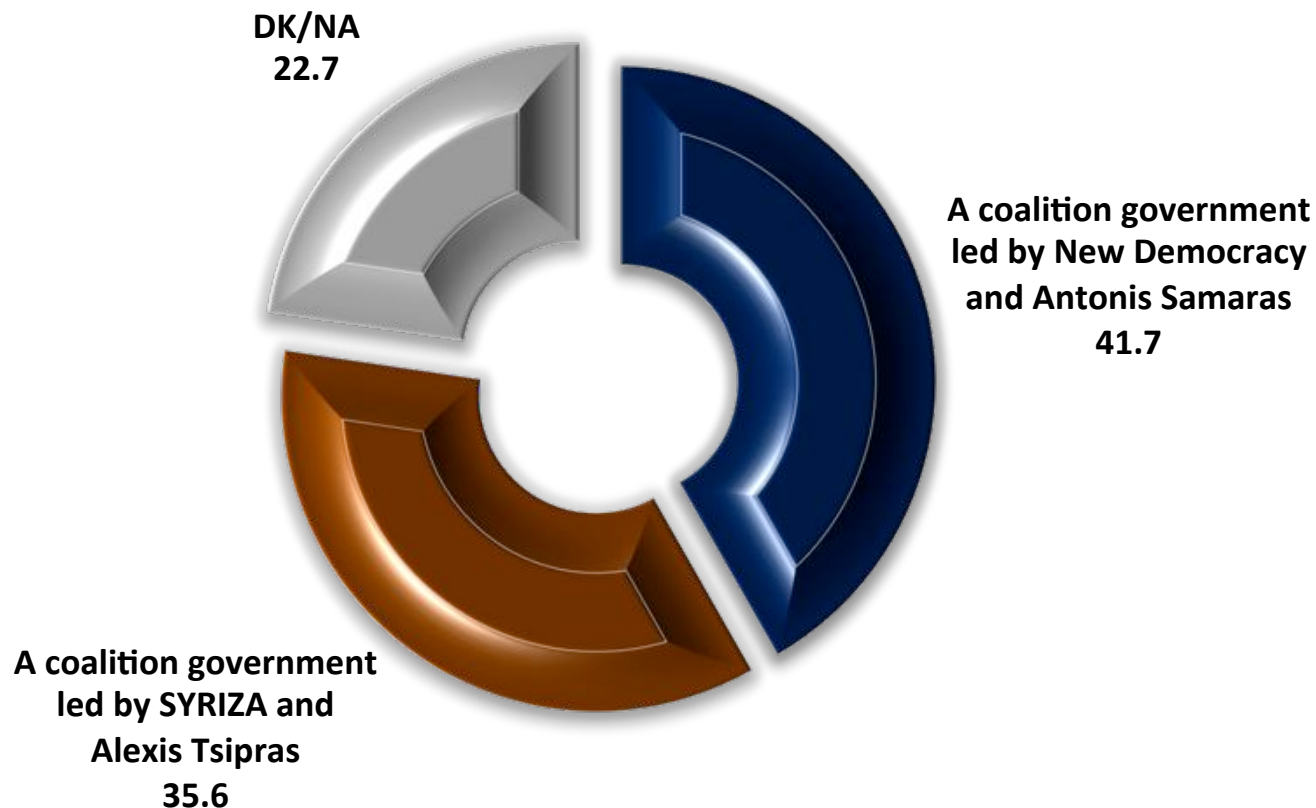


POLITICAL LEADERS POPULARITY

What is your opinion on each of the following political leaders?

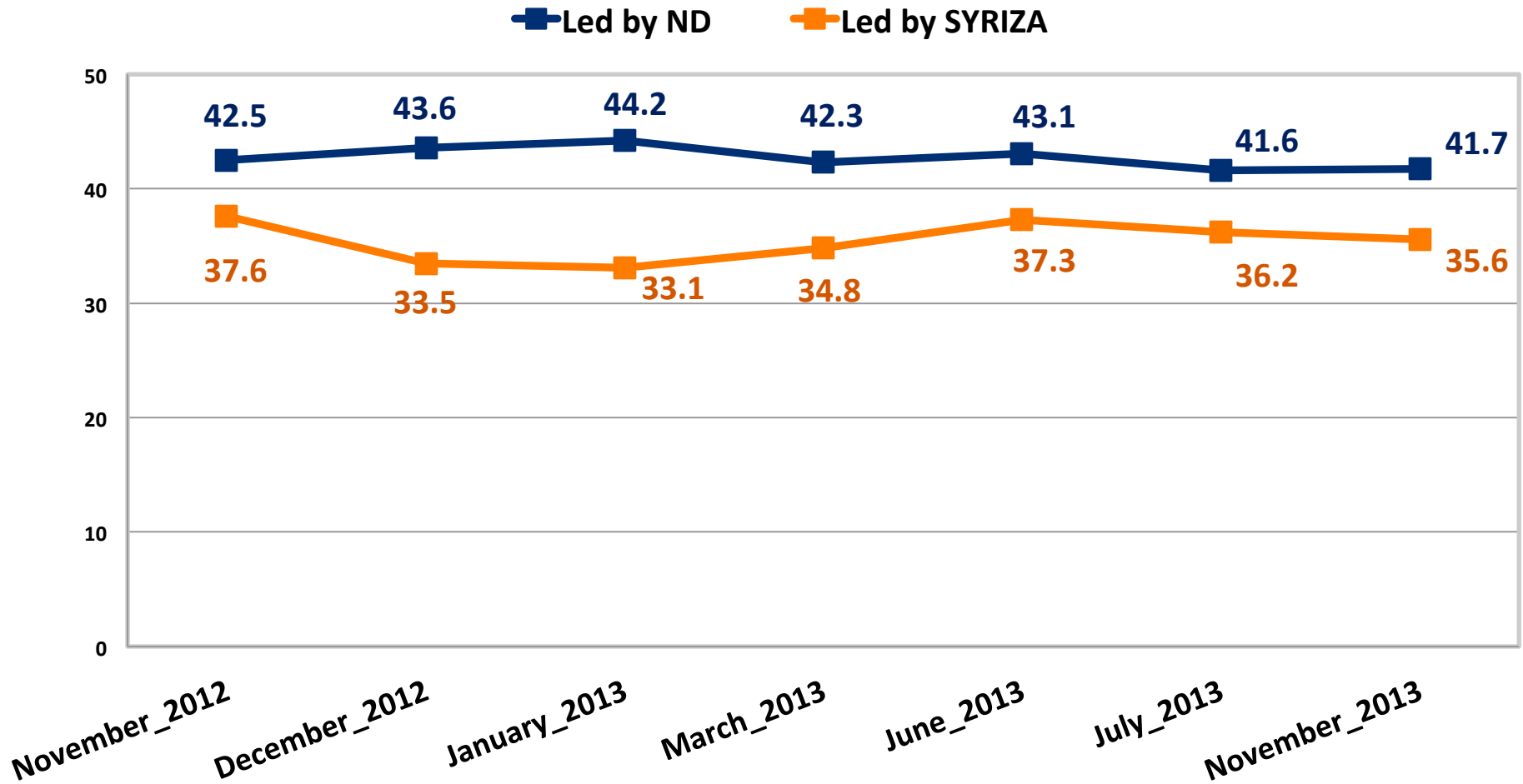


Which government would you consider more appropriate for the difficulties that the country's society and economy will have to face this decade?

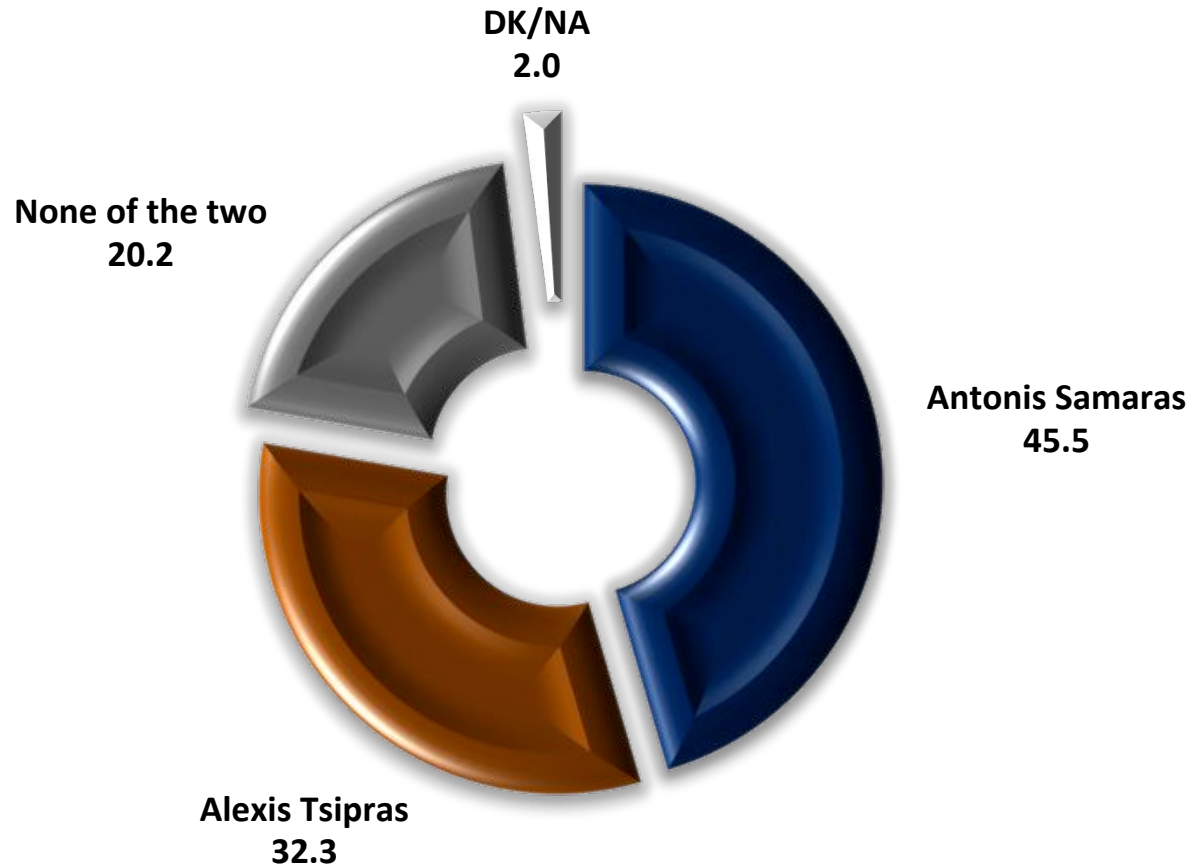


MORE APPROPRIATE GOVERNMENT

Over time

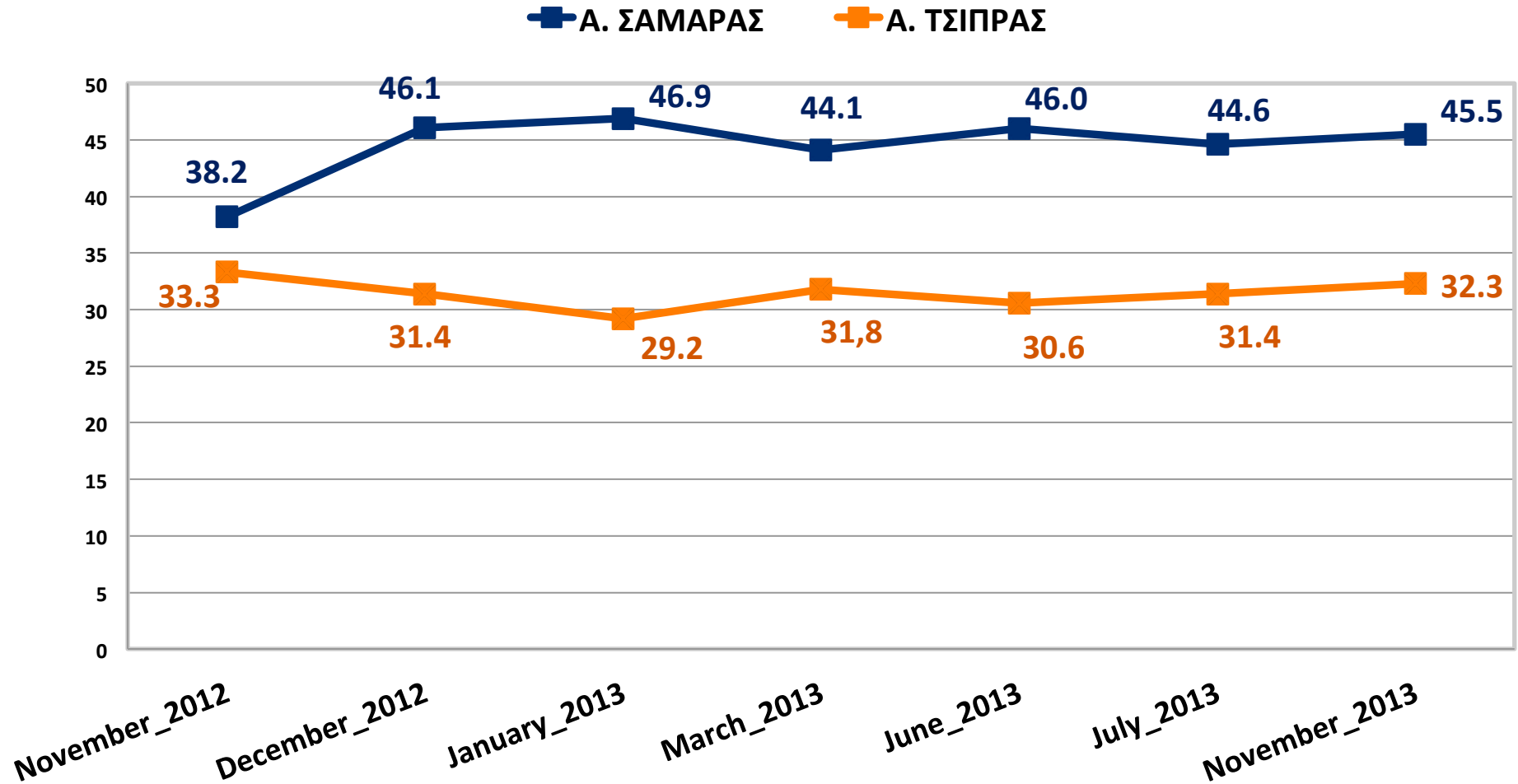


Between Antonis Samaras and Alexis Tsipras, who do you consider more appropriate for Prime Minister?



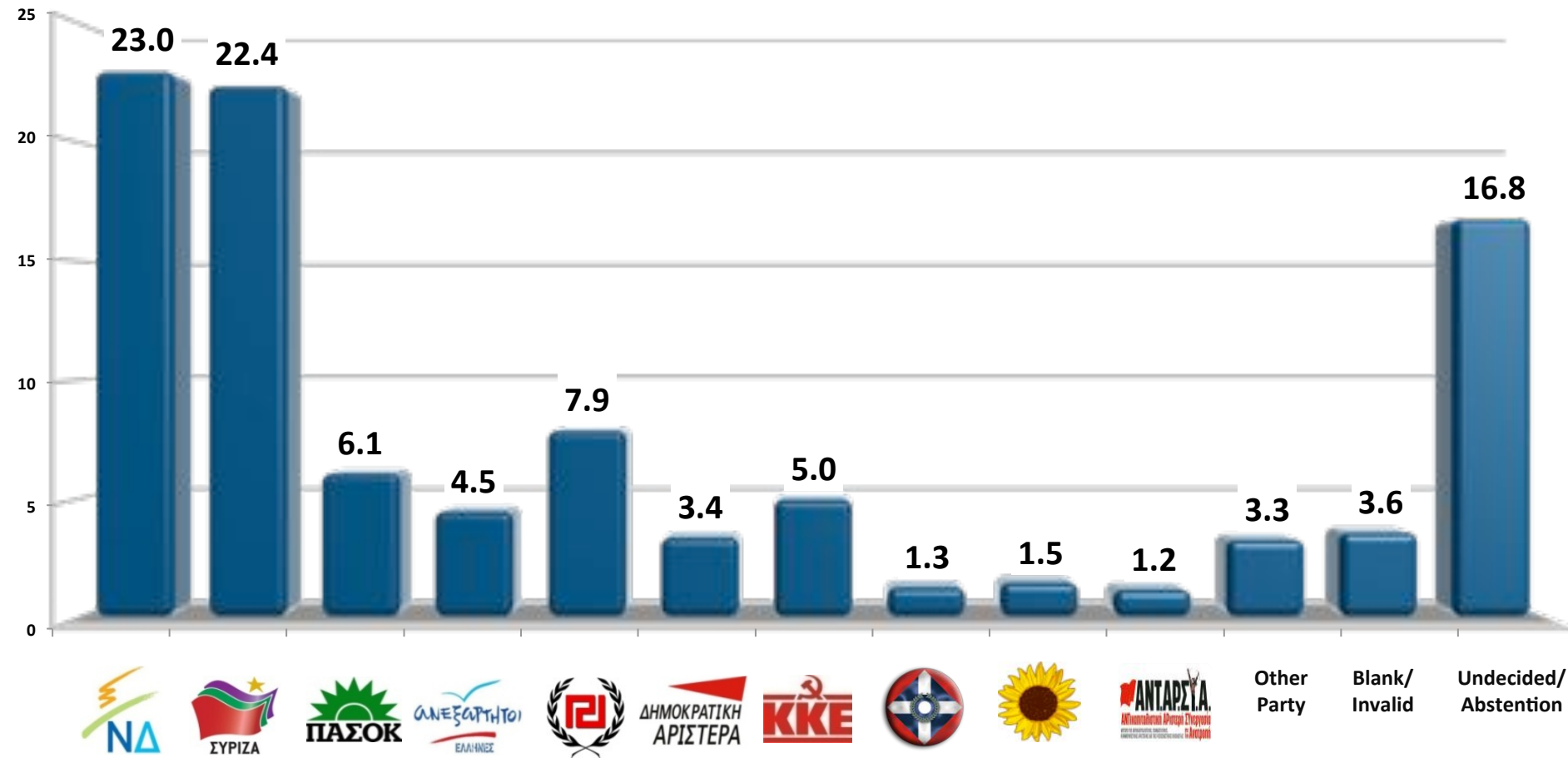
MORE APPROPRIATE FOR PRIME MINISTER

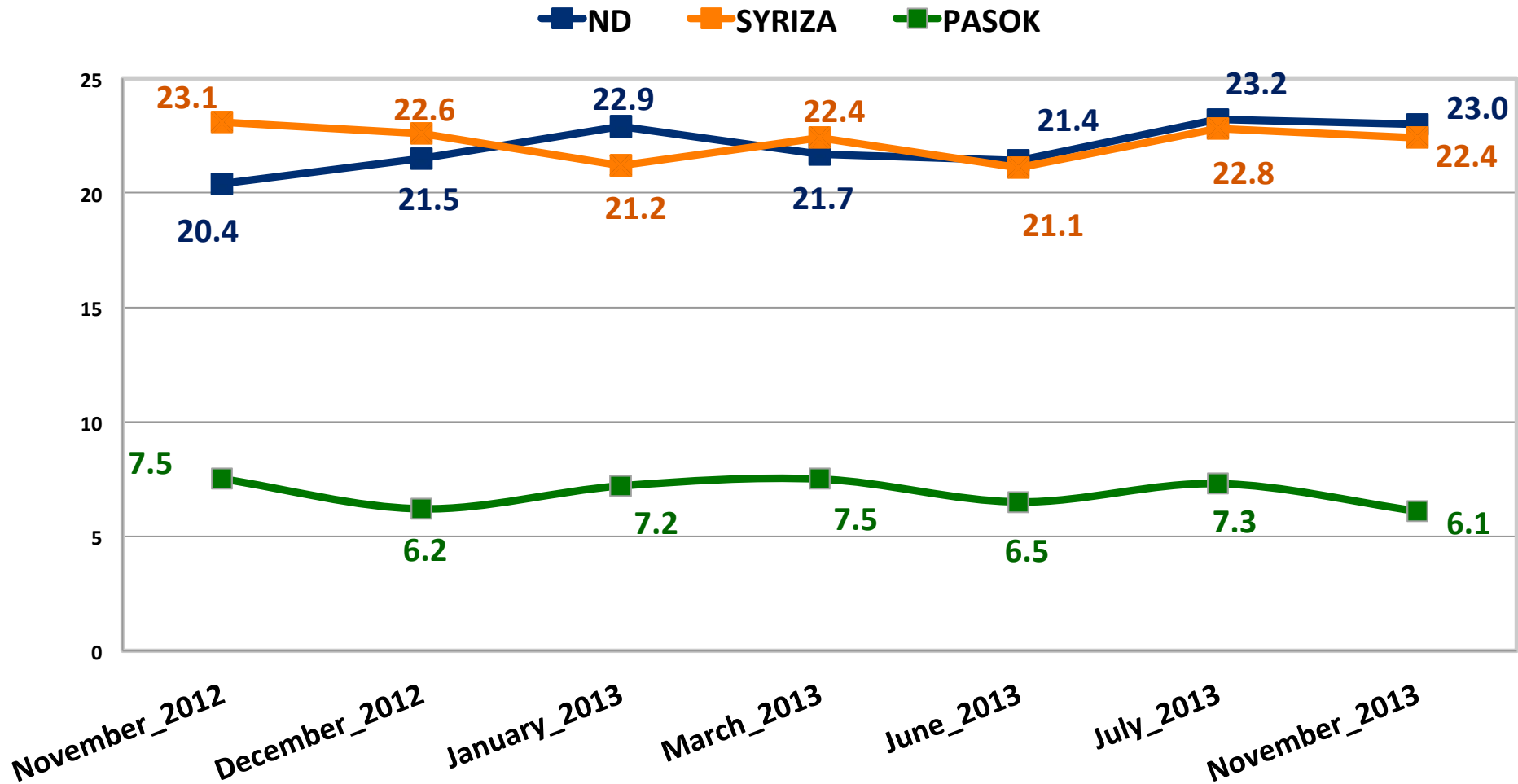
VOTING INTENTION

If parliamentary elections were to be held this Sunday, which party would you vote for?

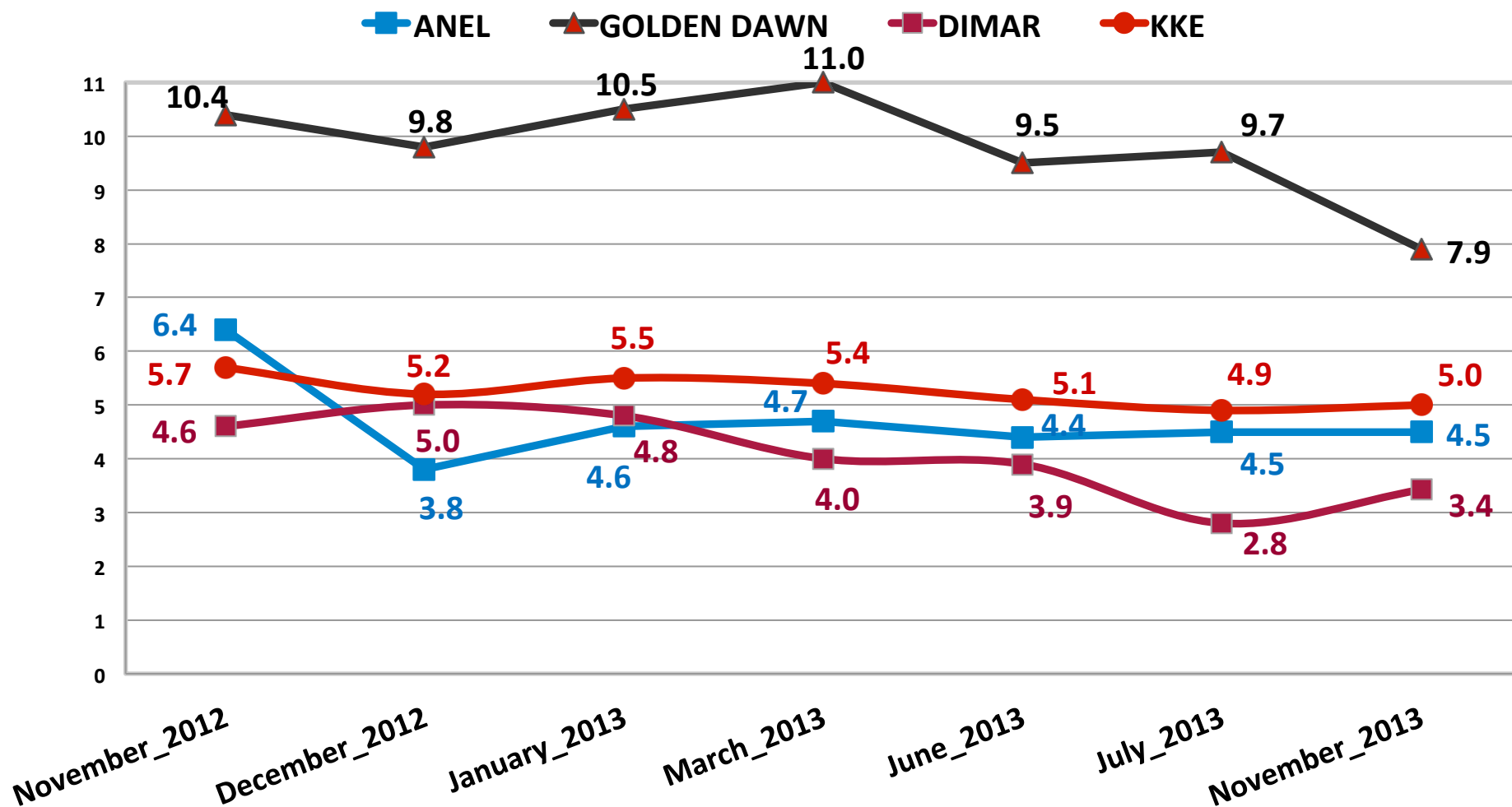


VOTING INTENTION: ND, SYRIZA & PASOK
